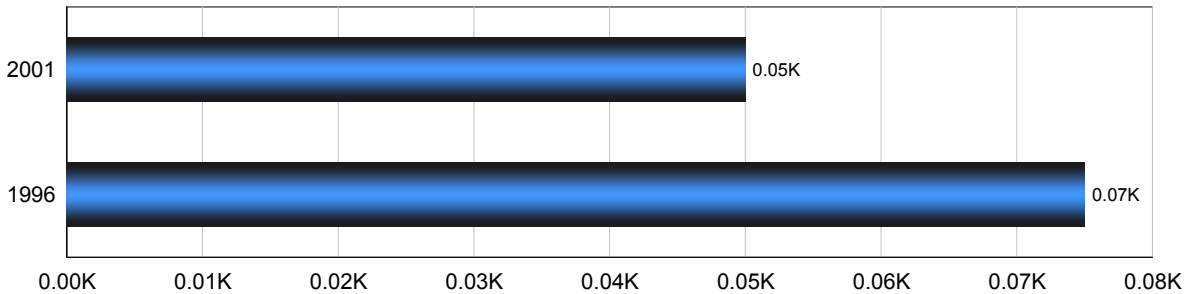

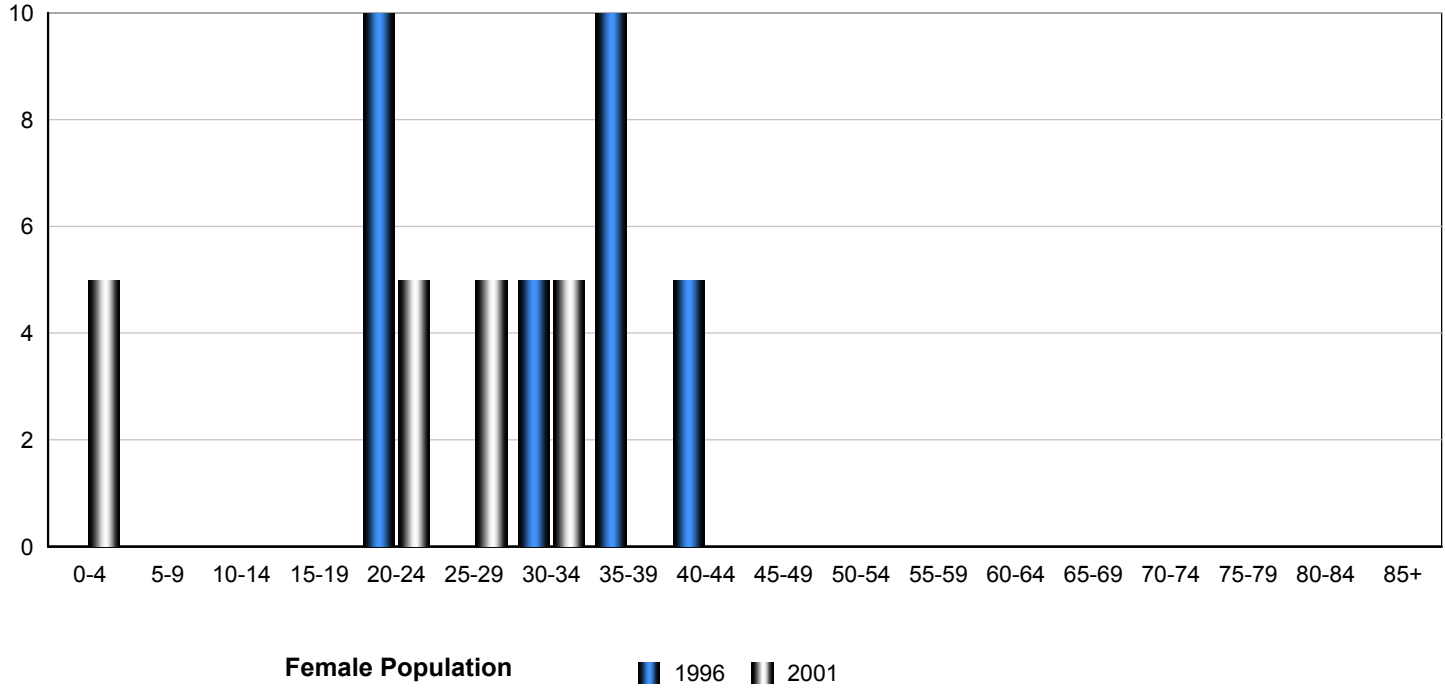

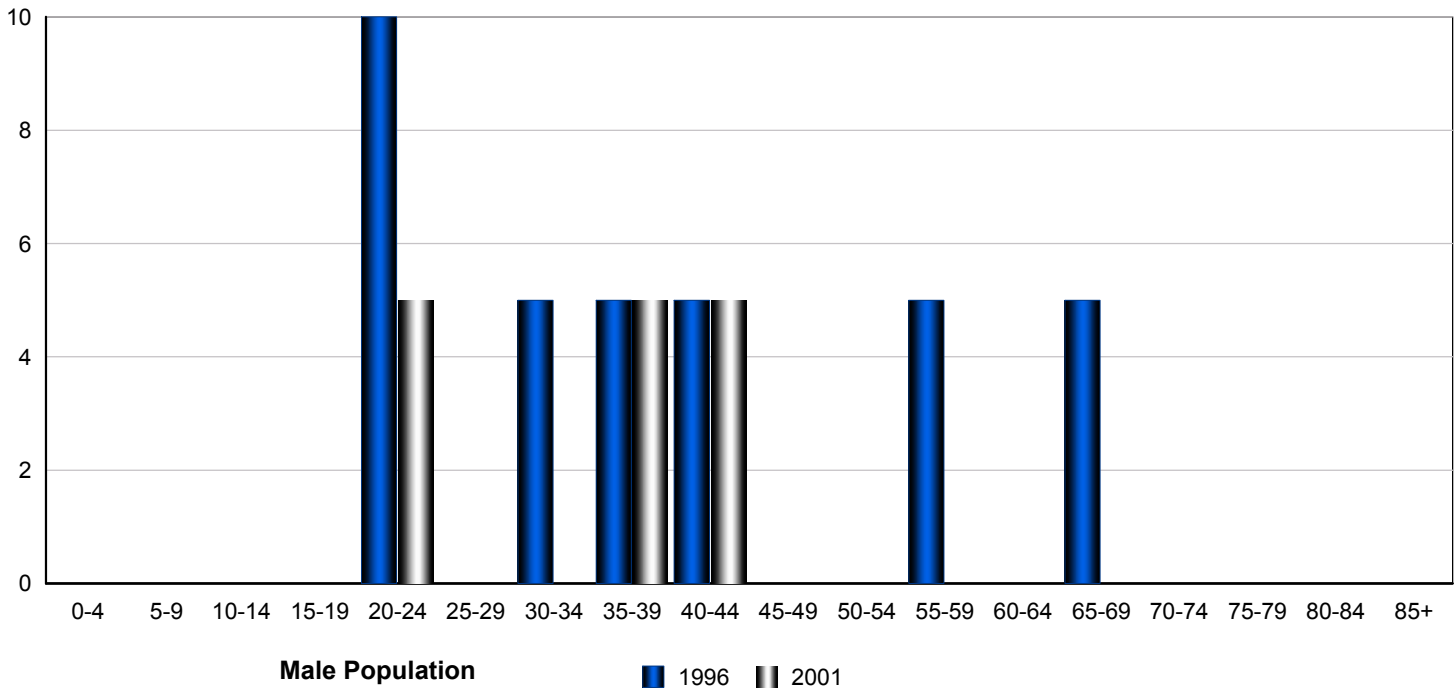

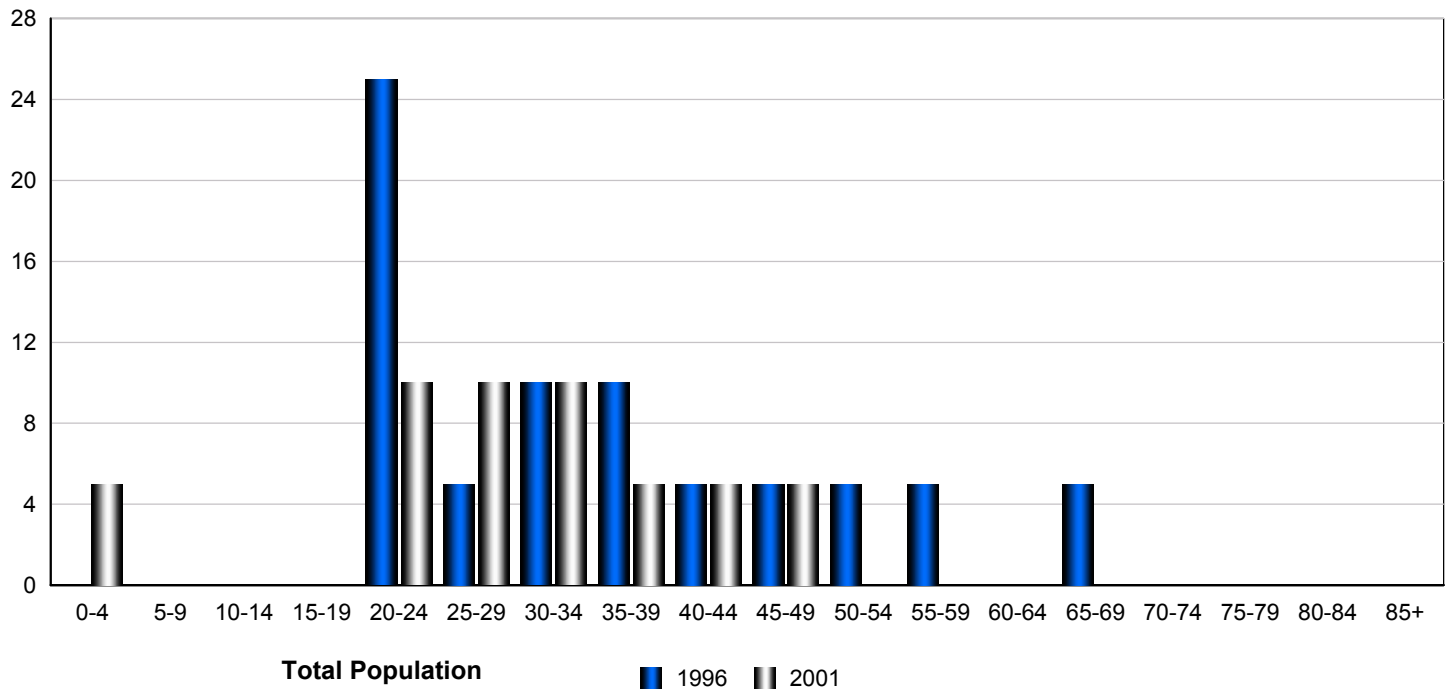

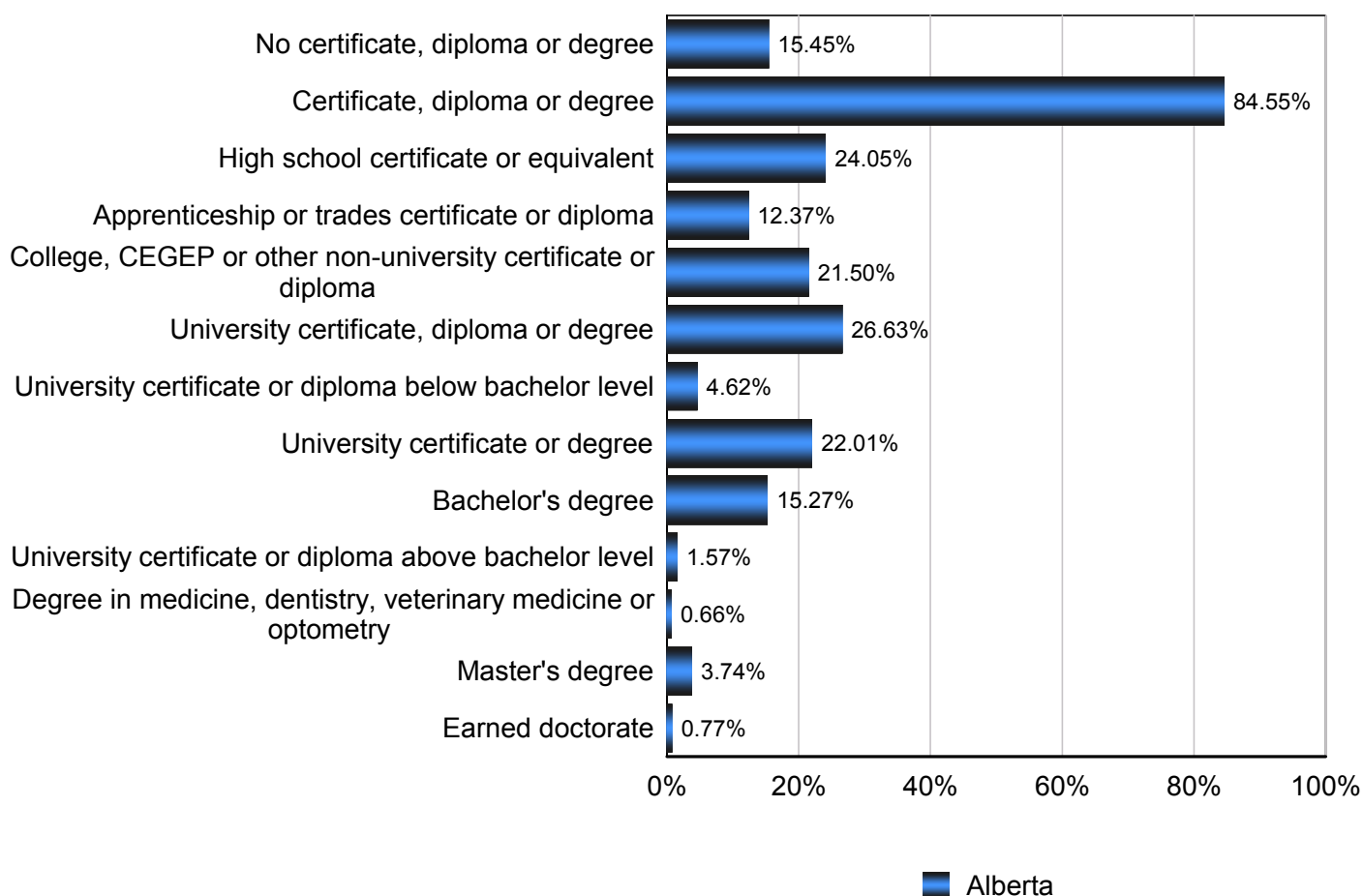

### Amount by Which the Highest Level of Schooling - vs Provincial Average (2006)

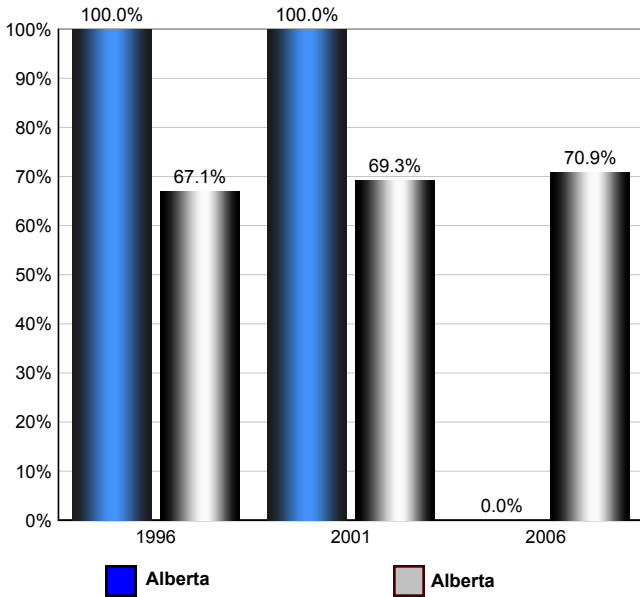

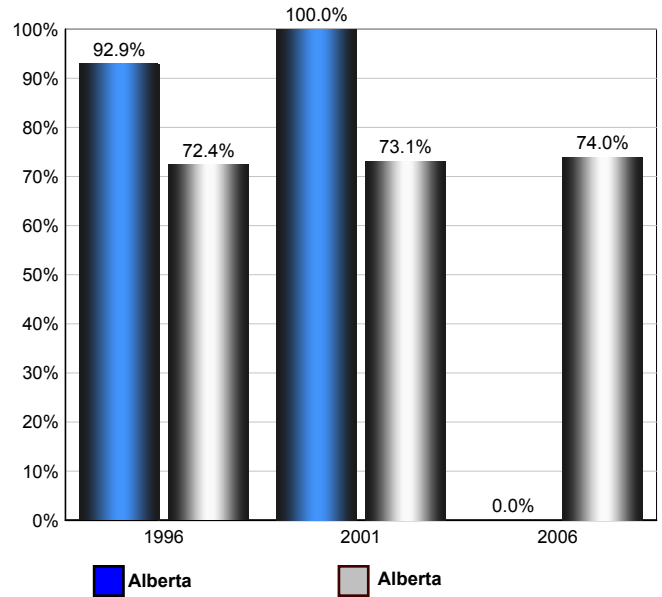
### Annual Labour Force Activity Rates - Alberta vs Alberta

#### Employment Rate



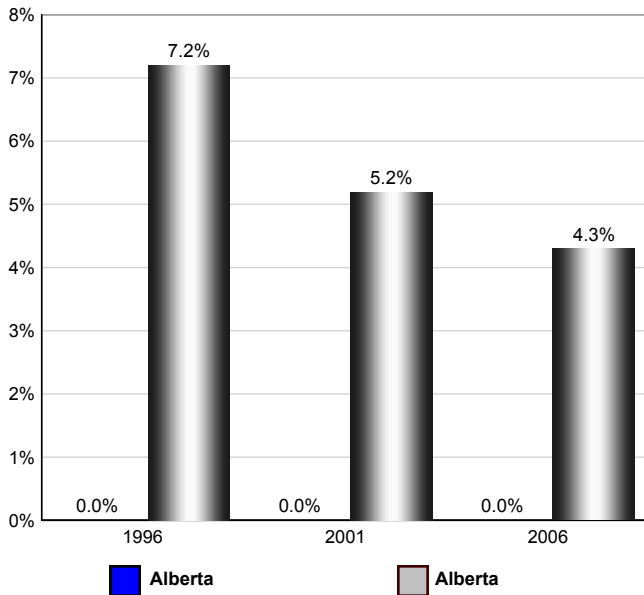
The Employment Rate is calculated by dividing the total employed by the total population 15 and over

#### Participation Rate



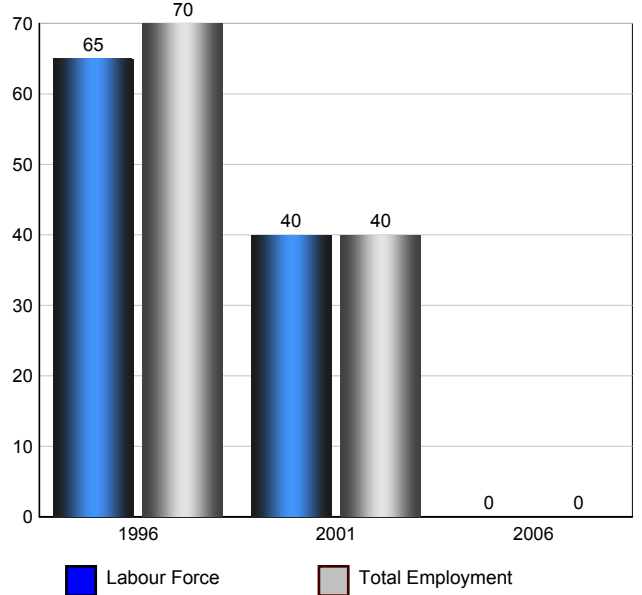
The Participation rate is calculated by summing together the number employed and unemployed and dividing the result by the total population aged 15 and over

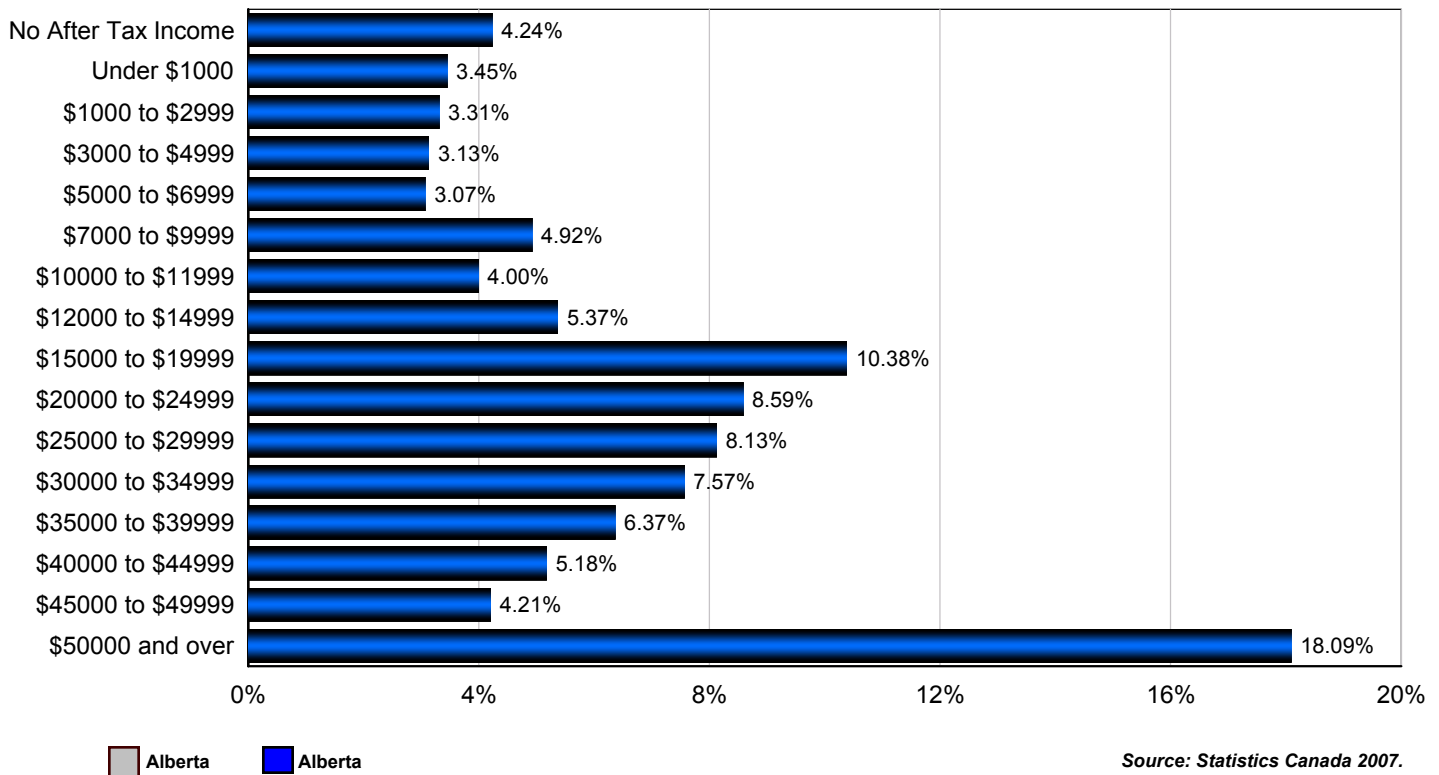

### Percent of Population 15+ by Income Bracket - Alberta vs Alberta (2005)



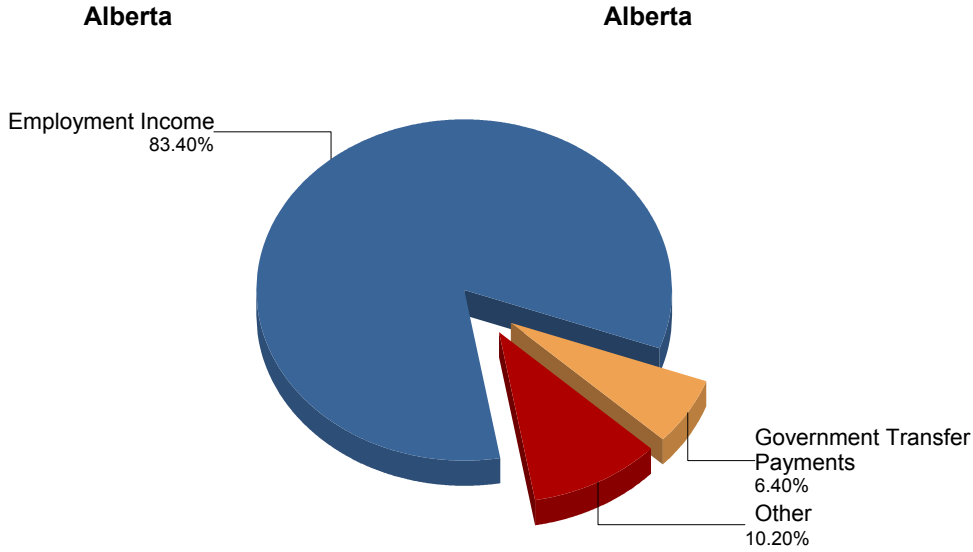

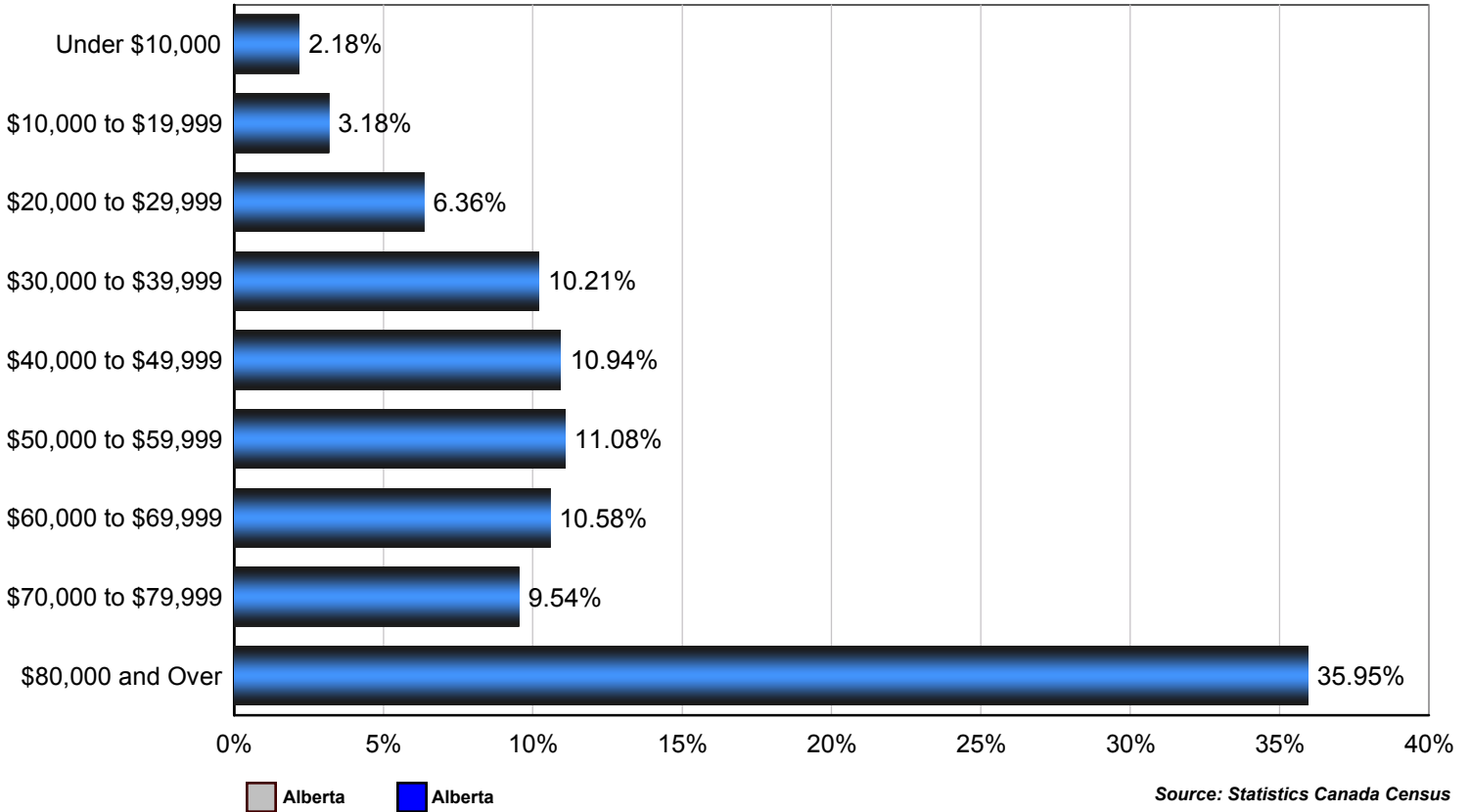

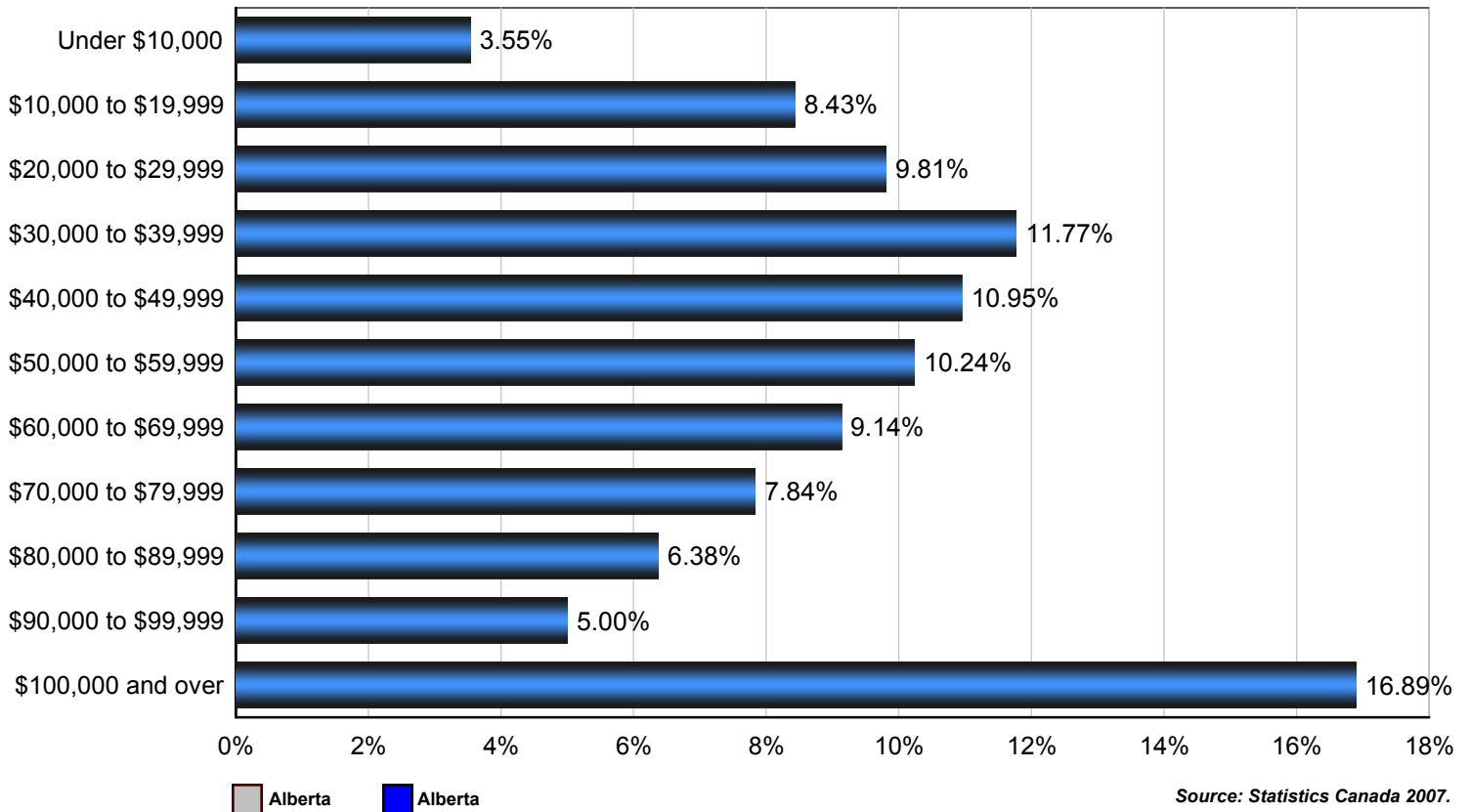

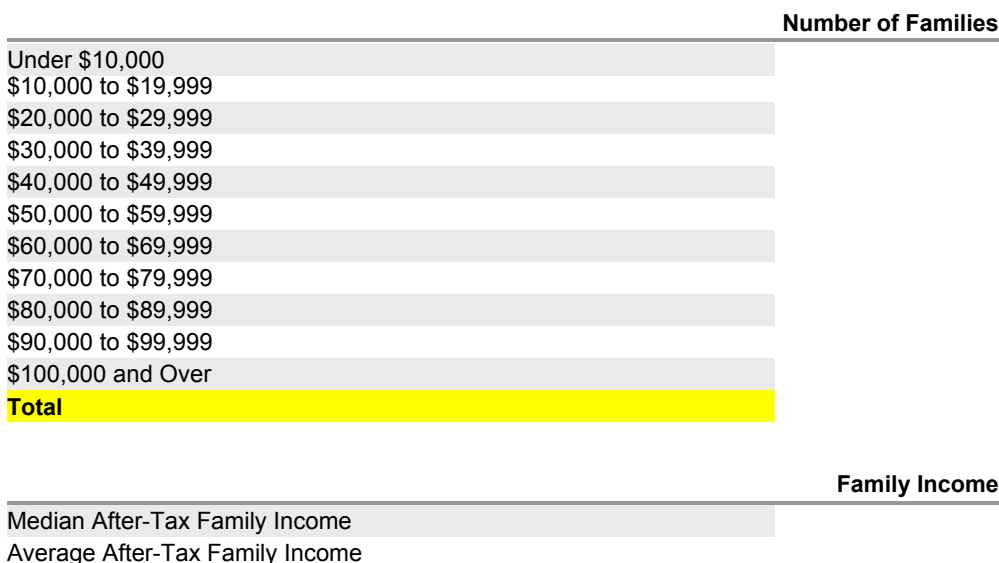

## Number of Private Households by After-tax Income Brackets - (2005)



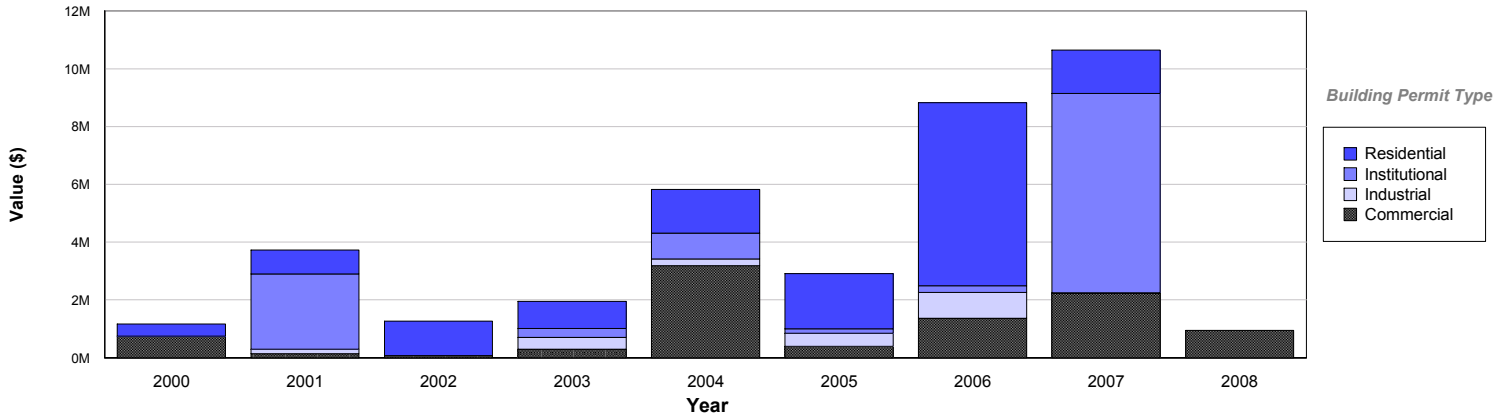

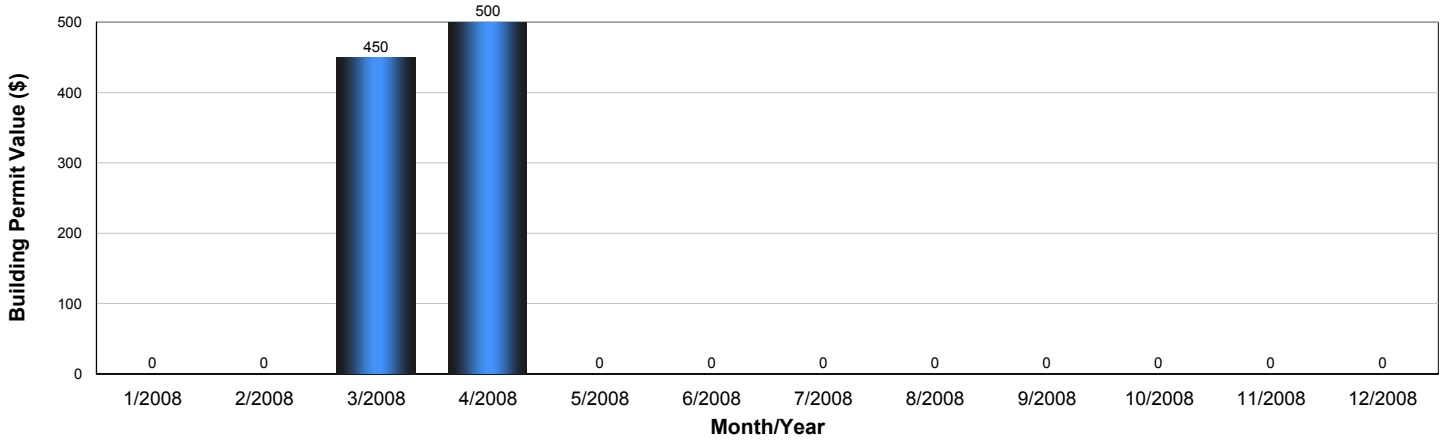

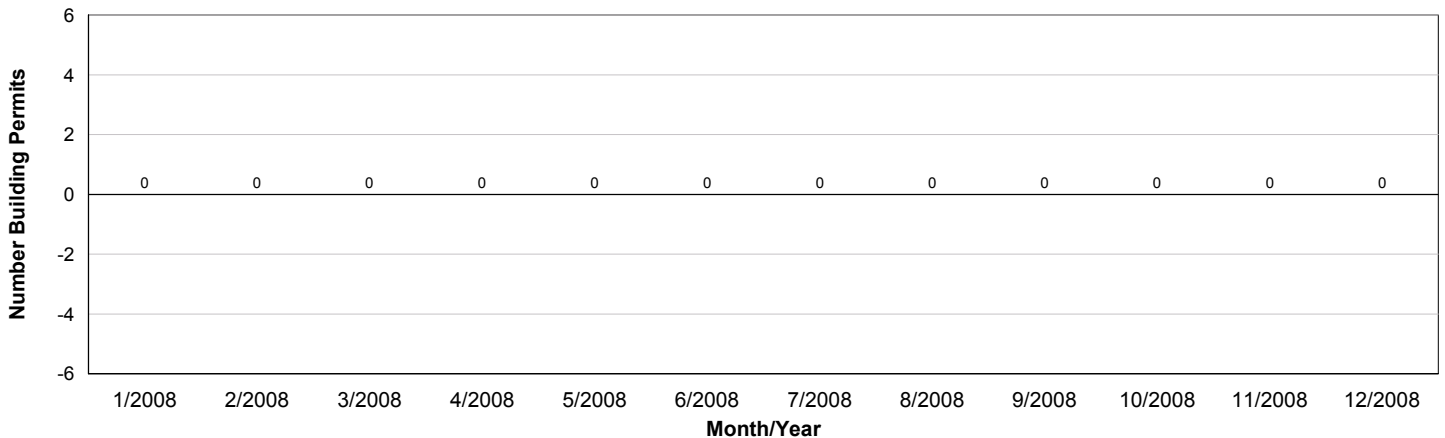

### Number of Building Permits - Jasper National Park, Improvement District No. 12



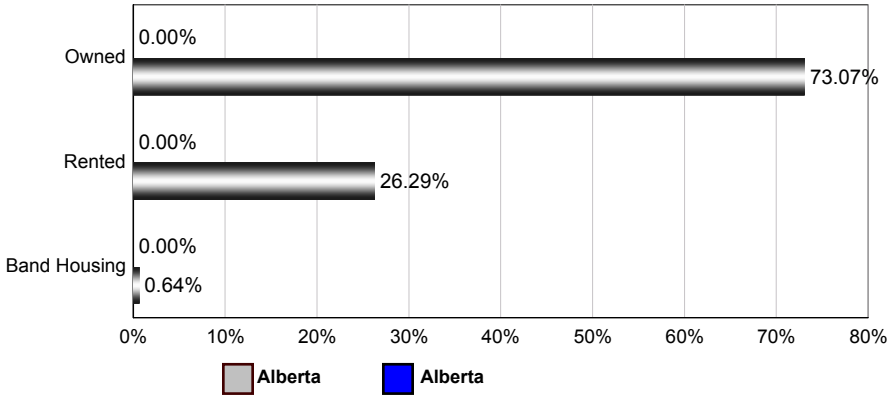

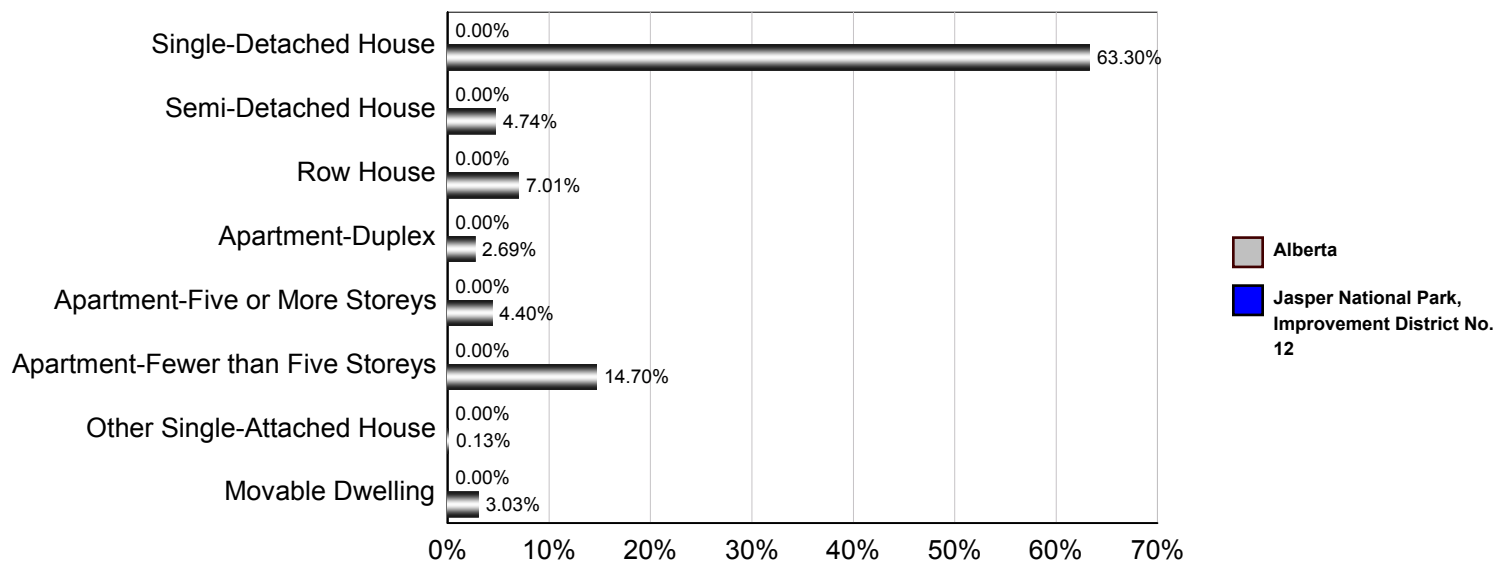

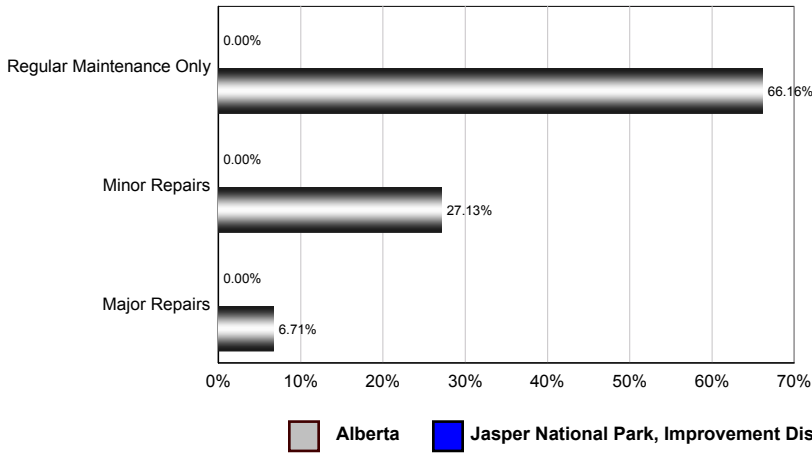

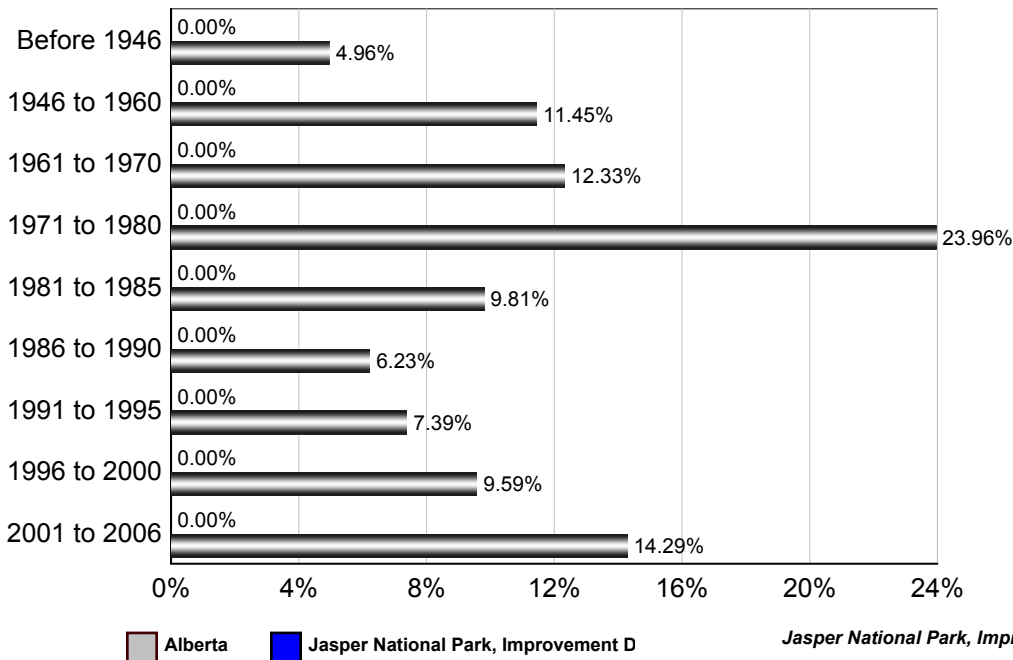

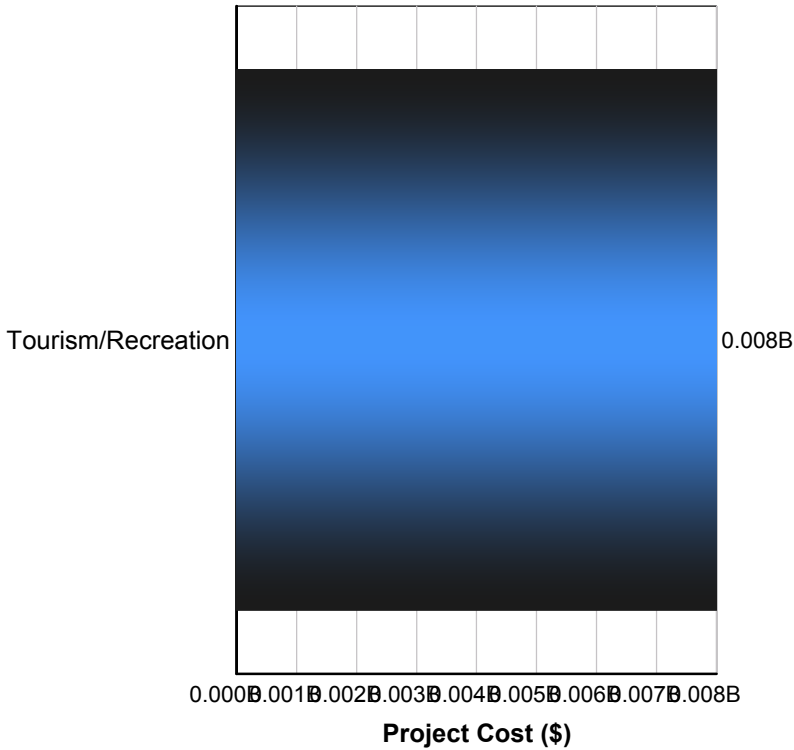

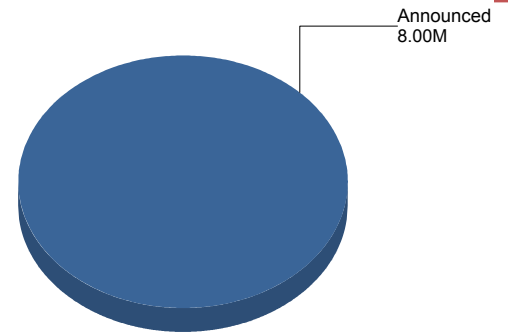
