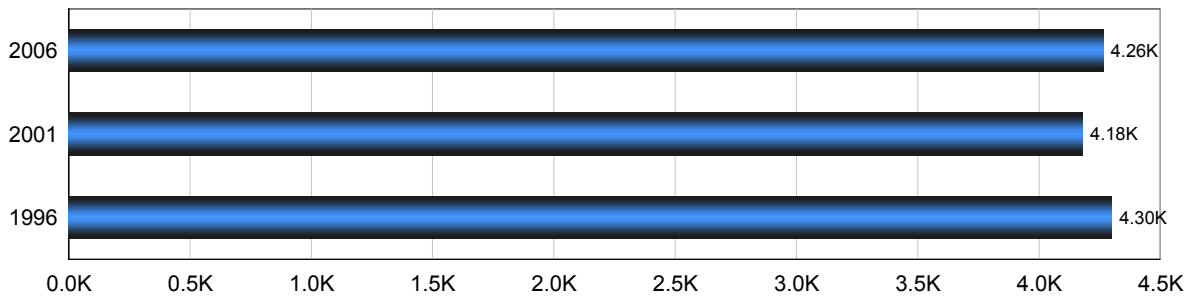

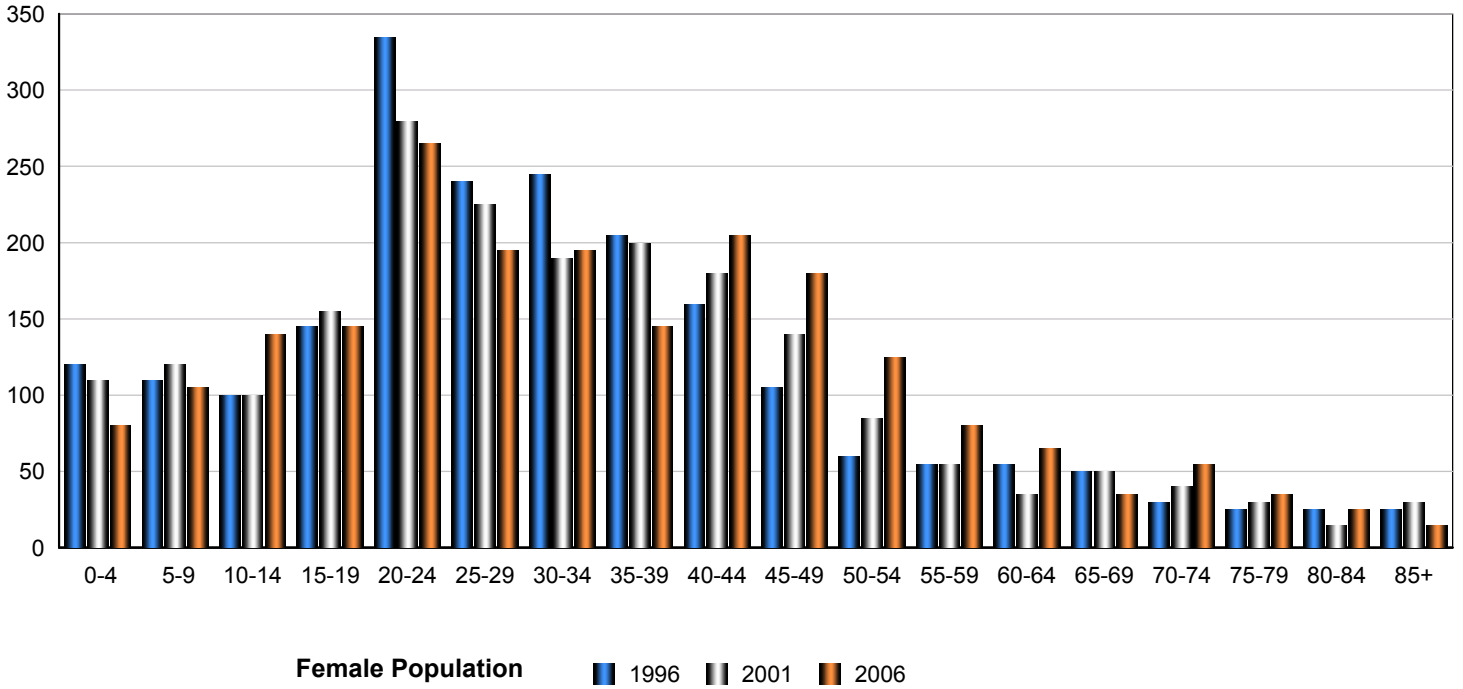

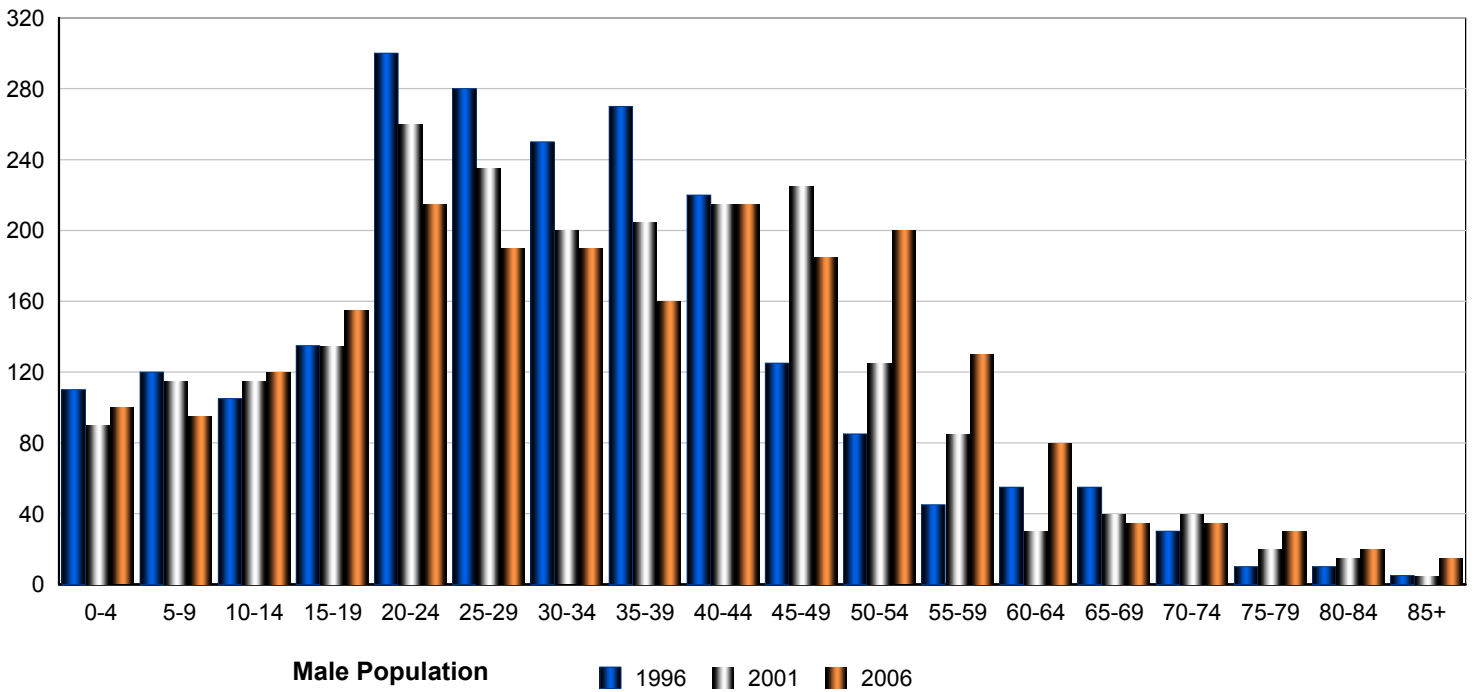

Total Population by Gender and Age - Jasper, Municipality of

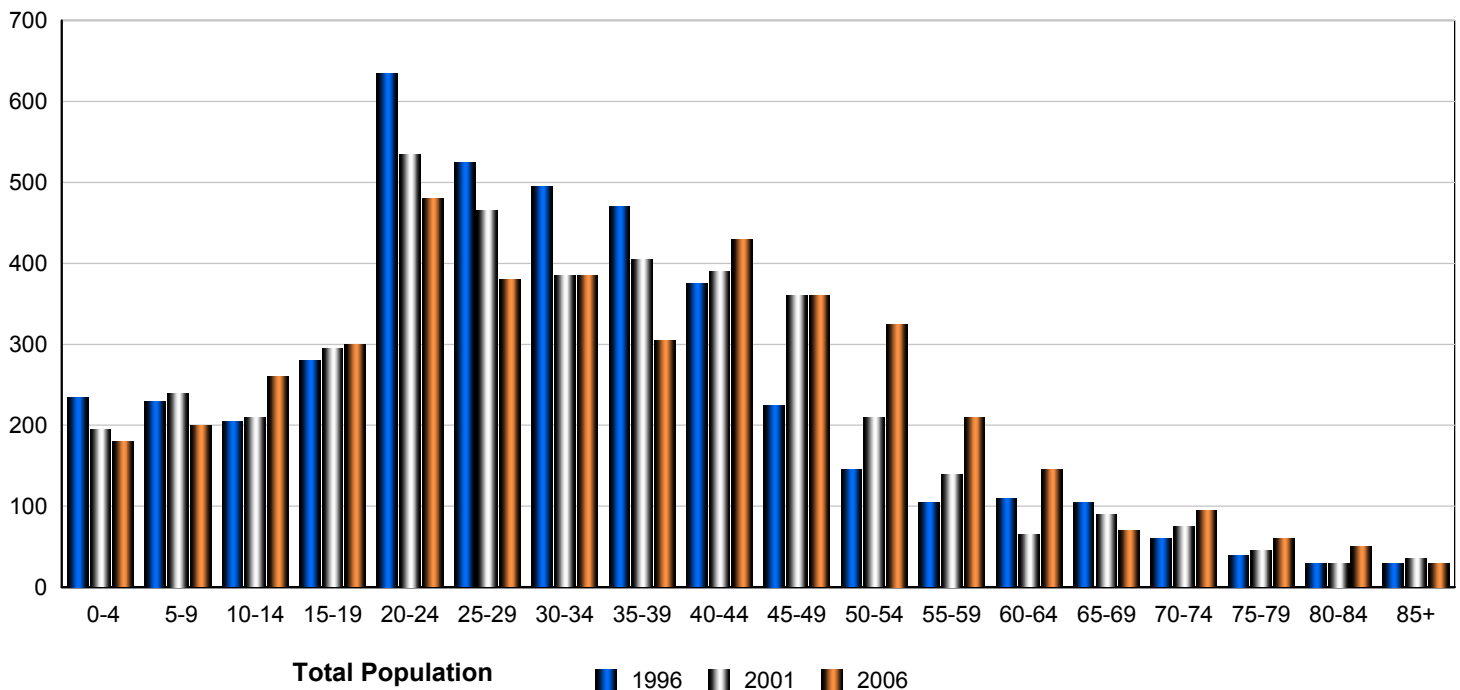
Census Population by Gender - Jasper, Municipality of

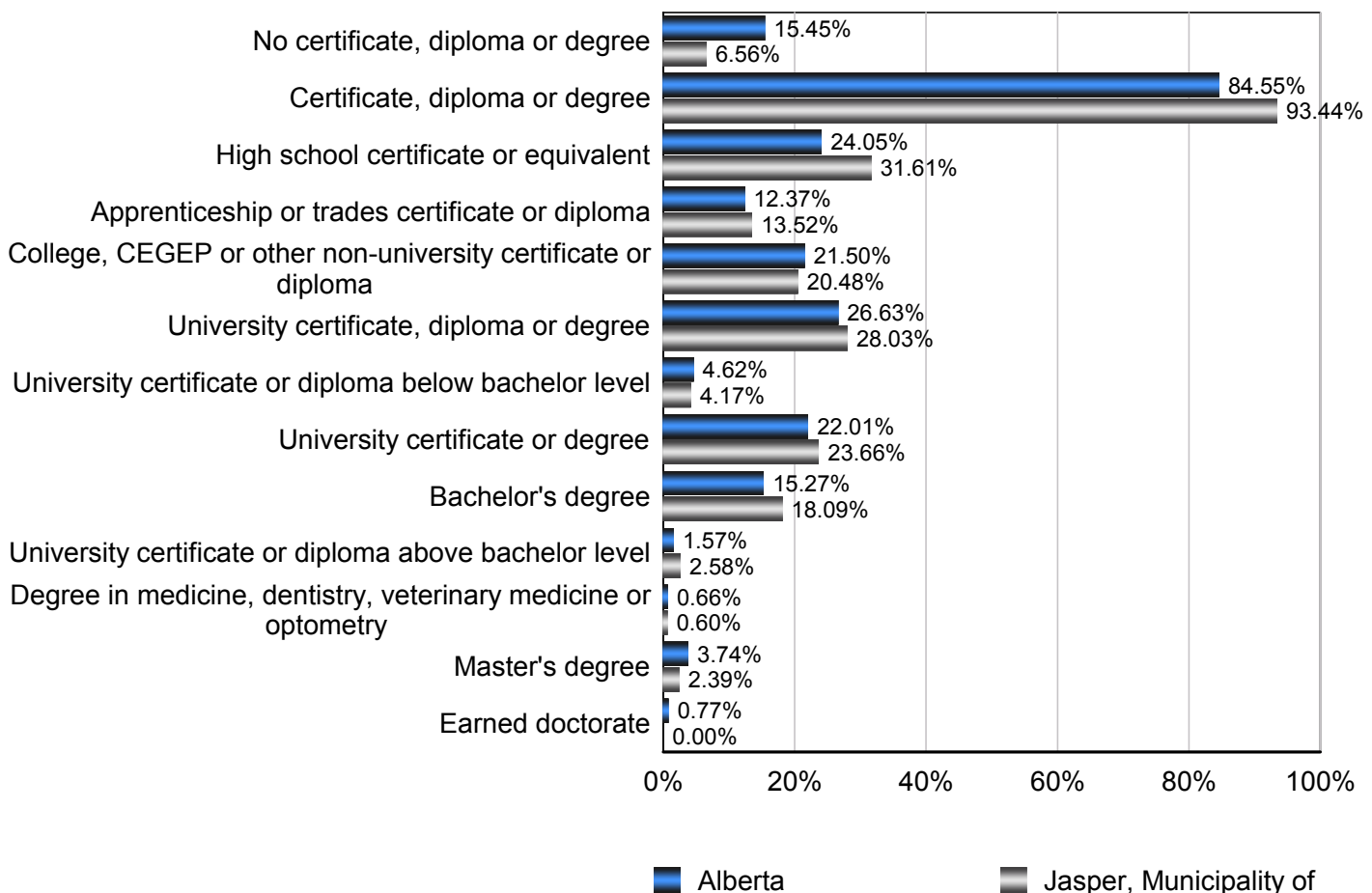

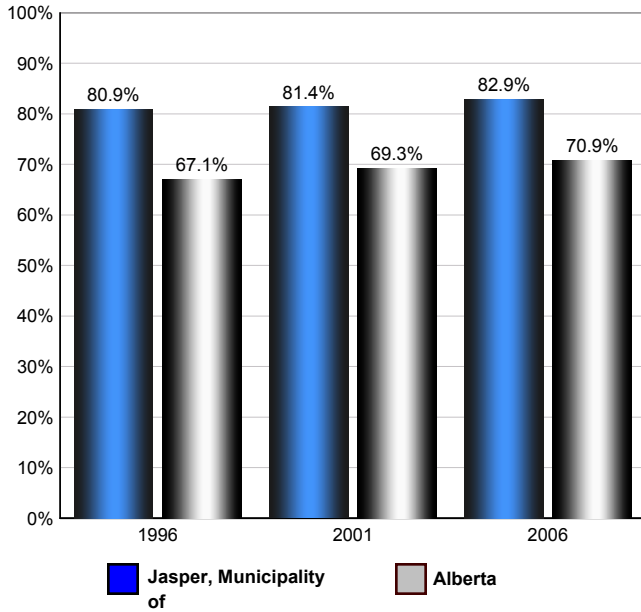

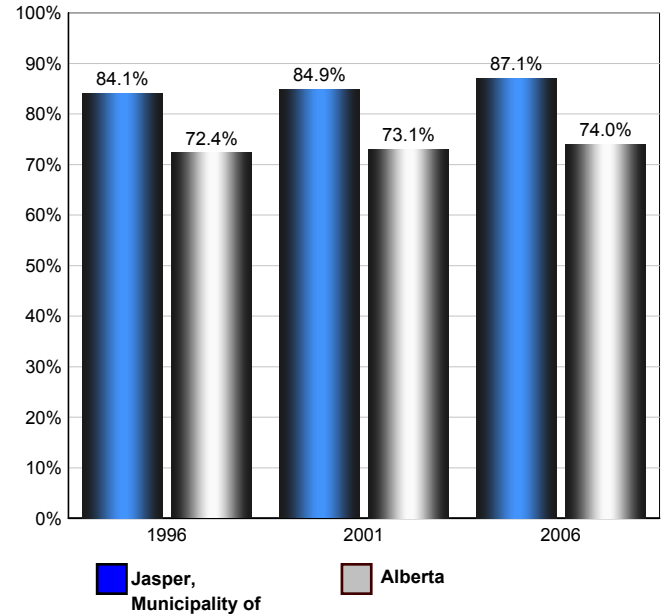
Annual Labour Force Activity Rates - Jasper, Municipality of vs Alberta

Employment Rate



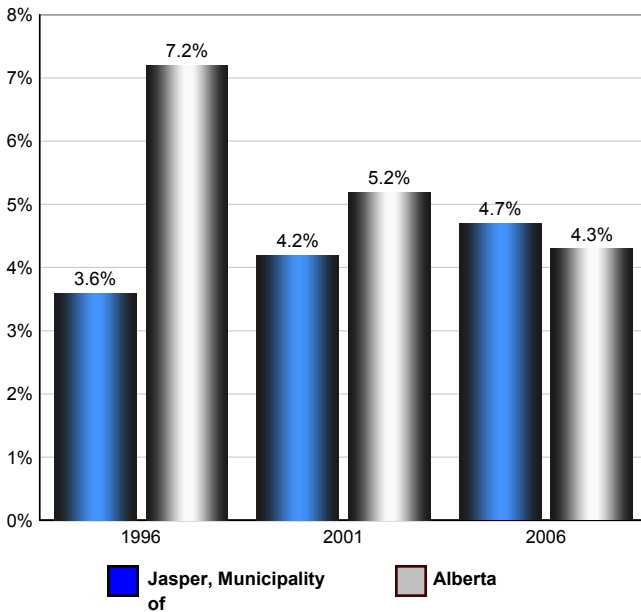
Employment Rate is calculated by dividing the total employed by the total population 15 and over

Participation Rate



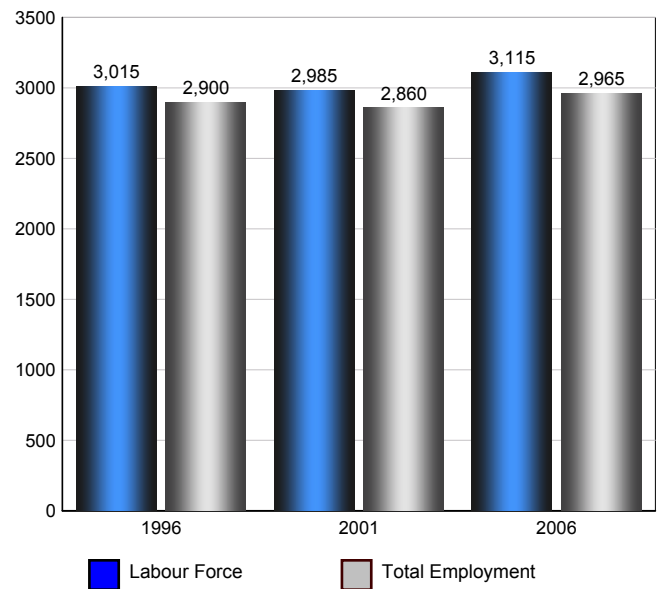
The Participation rate is calculated by summing together the number employed and unemployed and dividing the result by the total population aged 15 and over

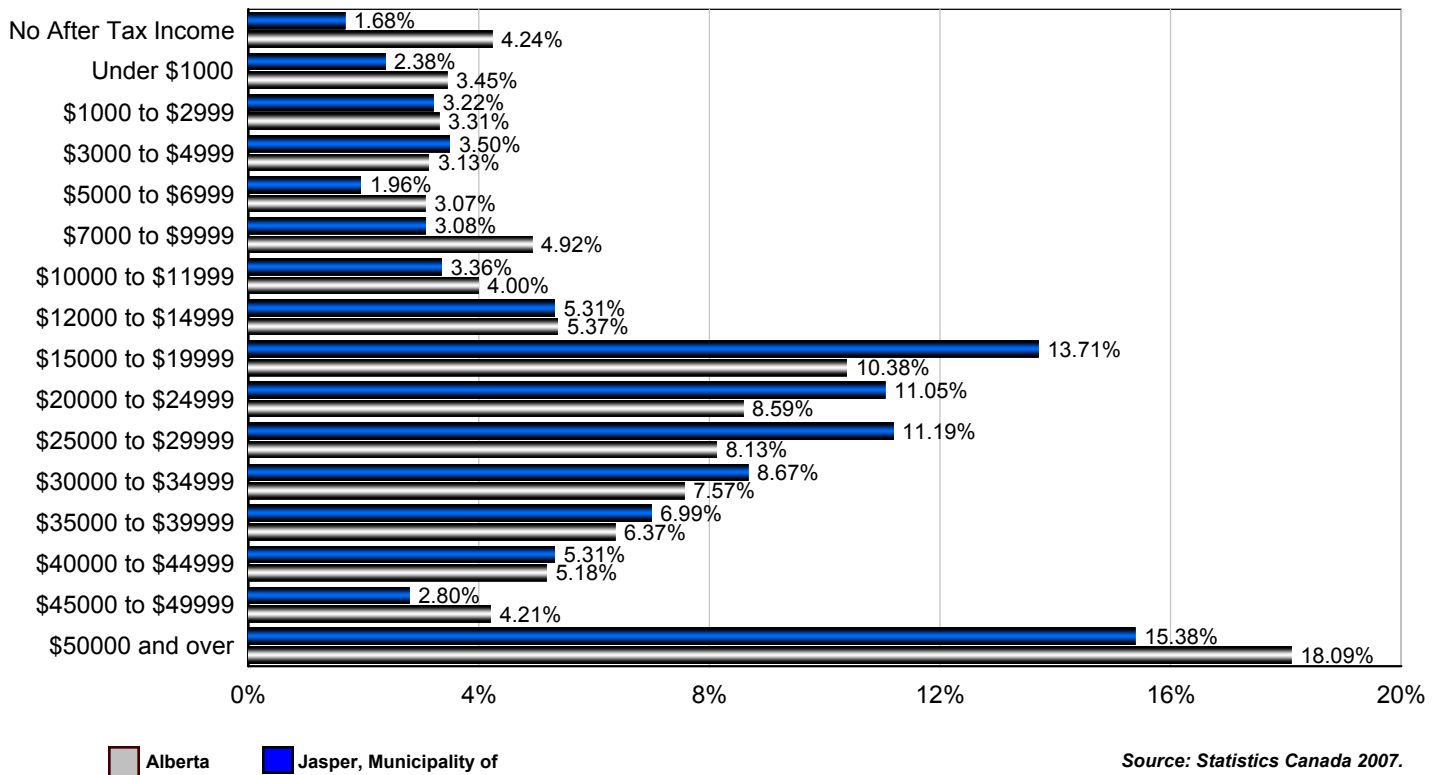

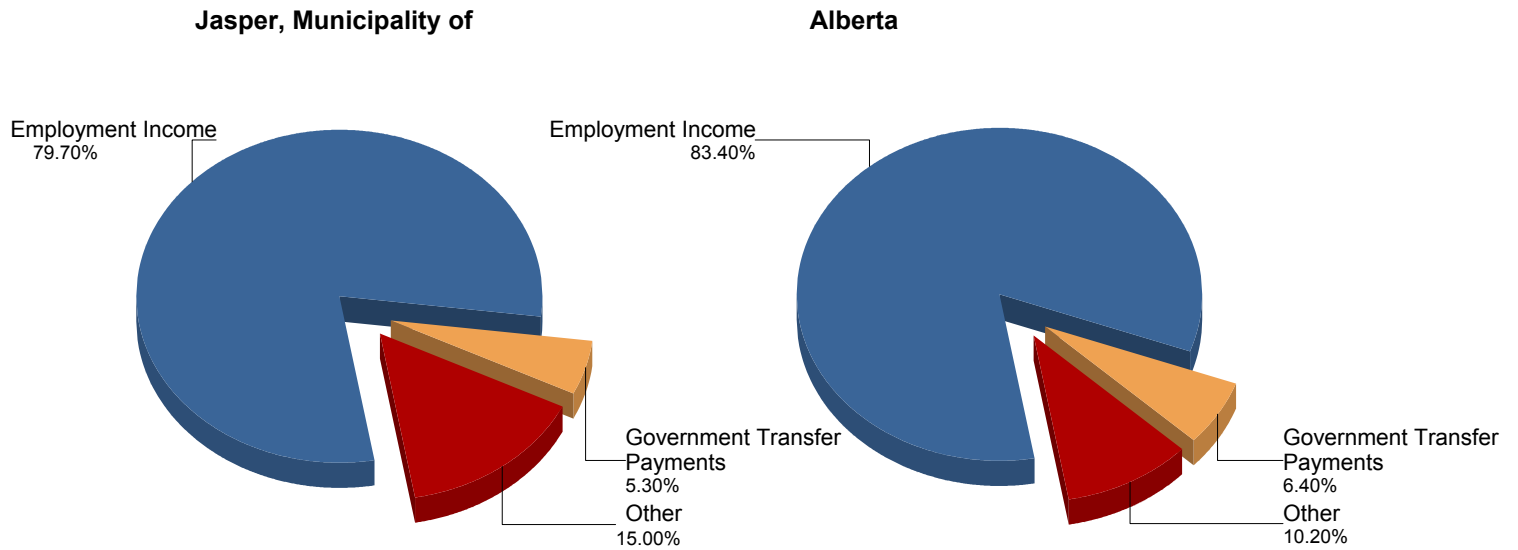

Economic family total income - The total income of an economic family is the sum of the total incomes of all members of that family.

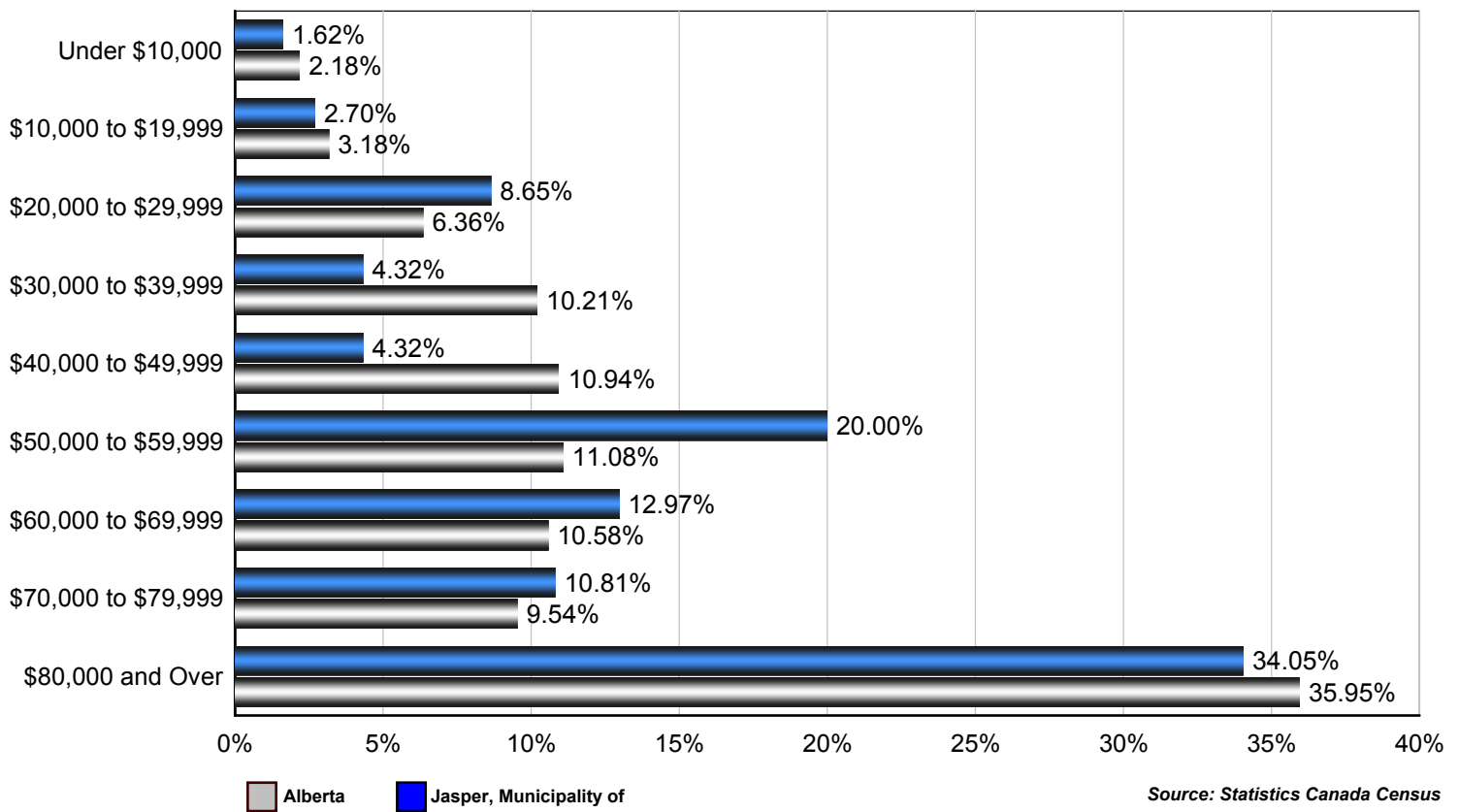

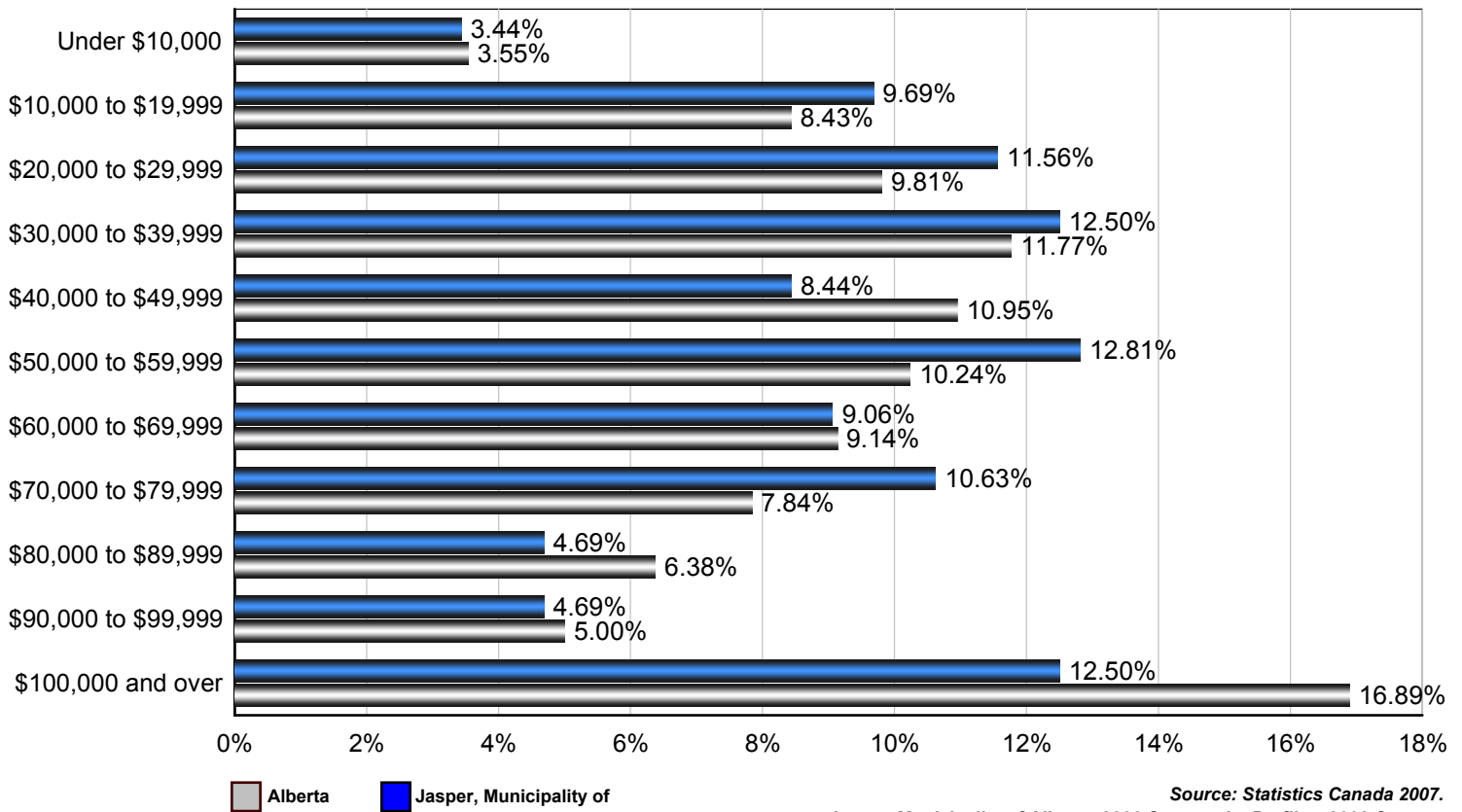

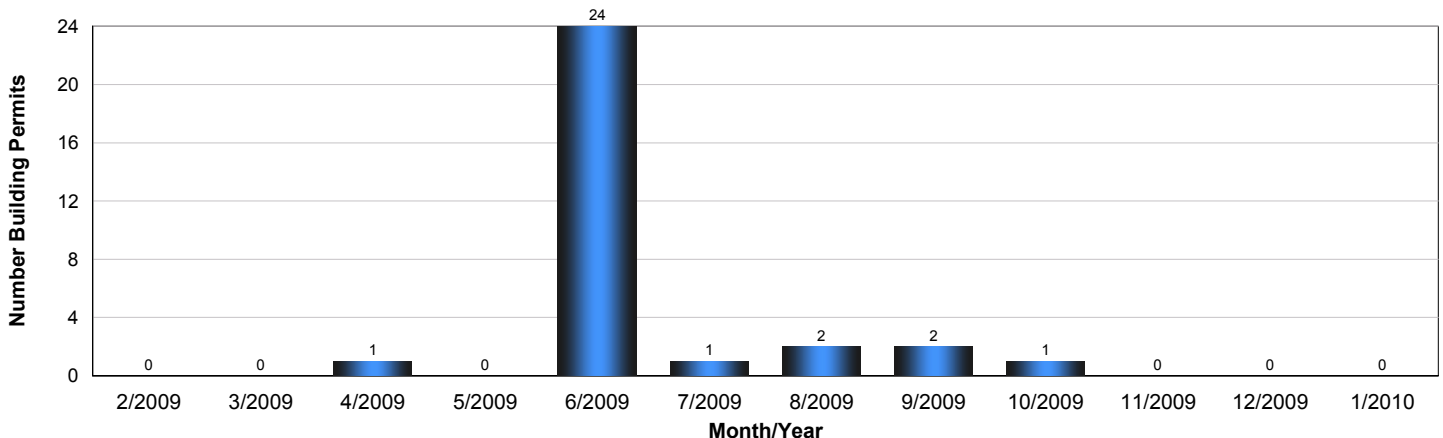

Number of Building Permits - Jasper, Municipality of

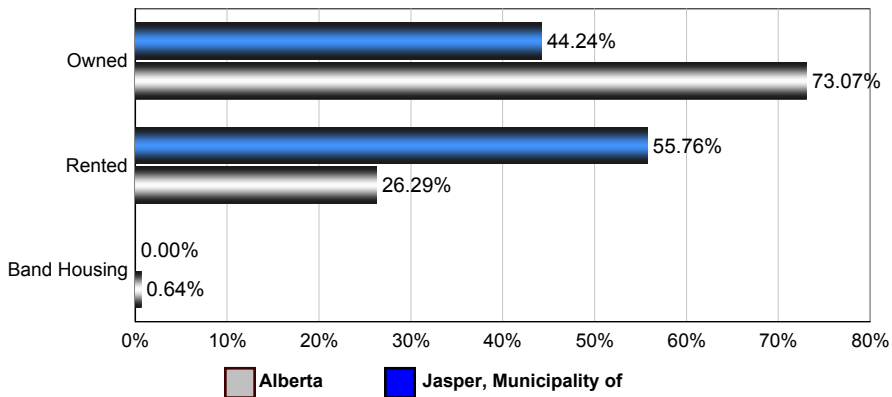

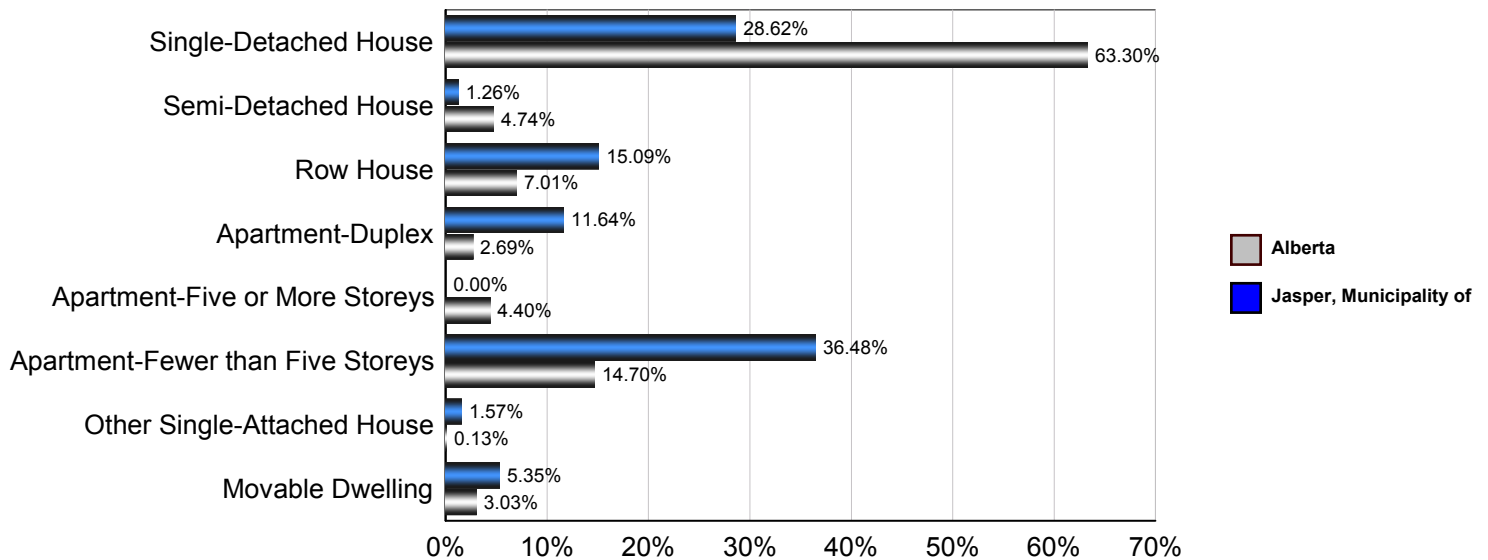

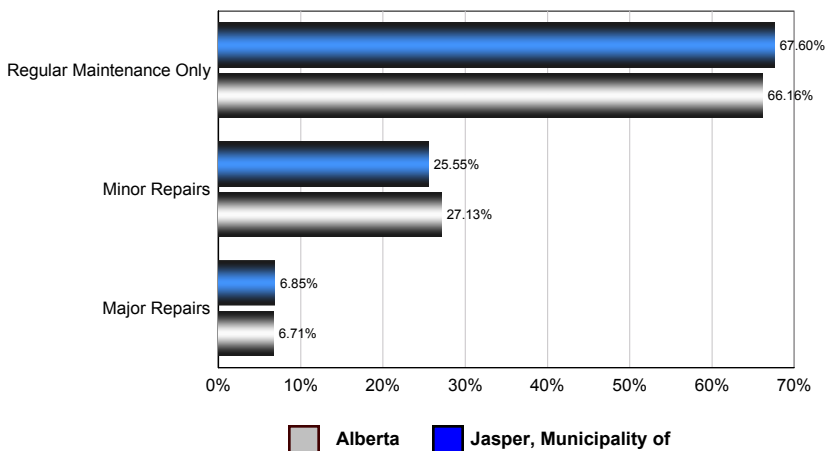

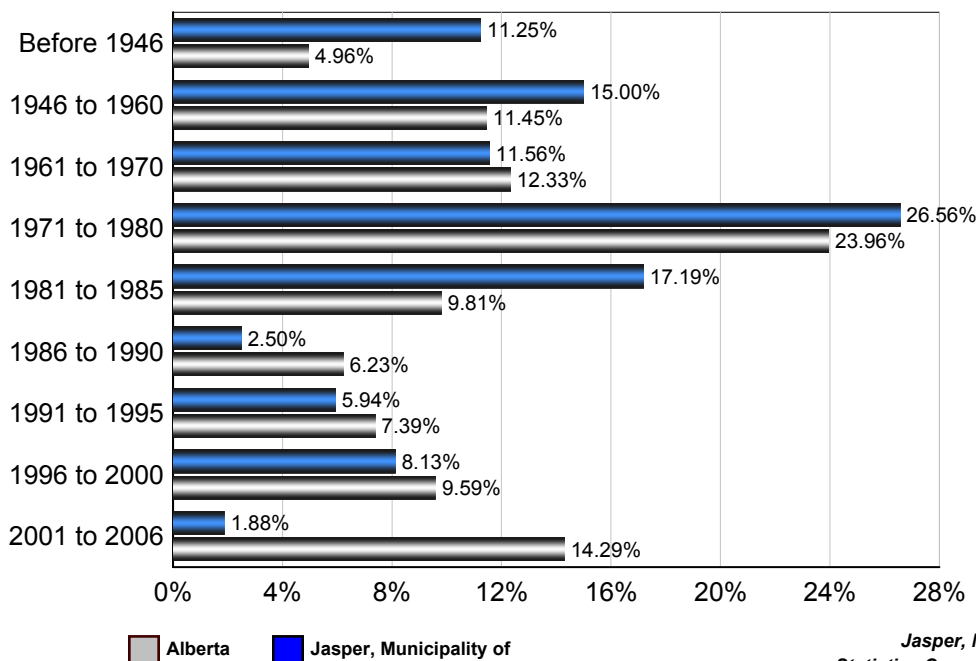
