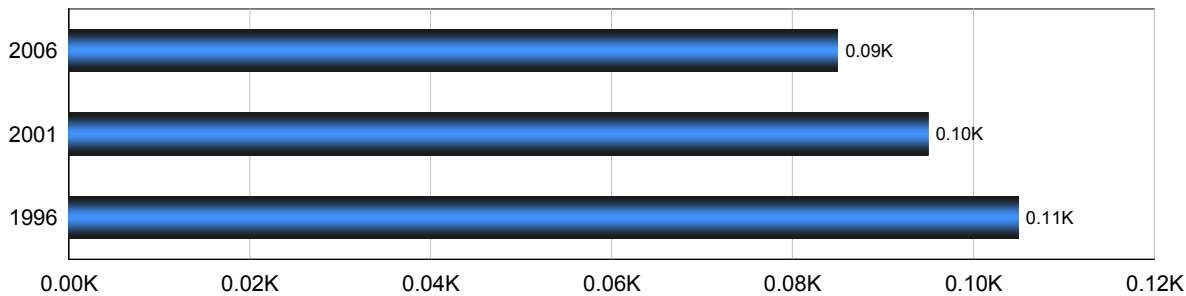

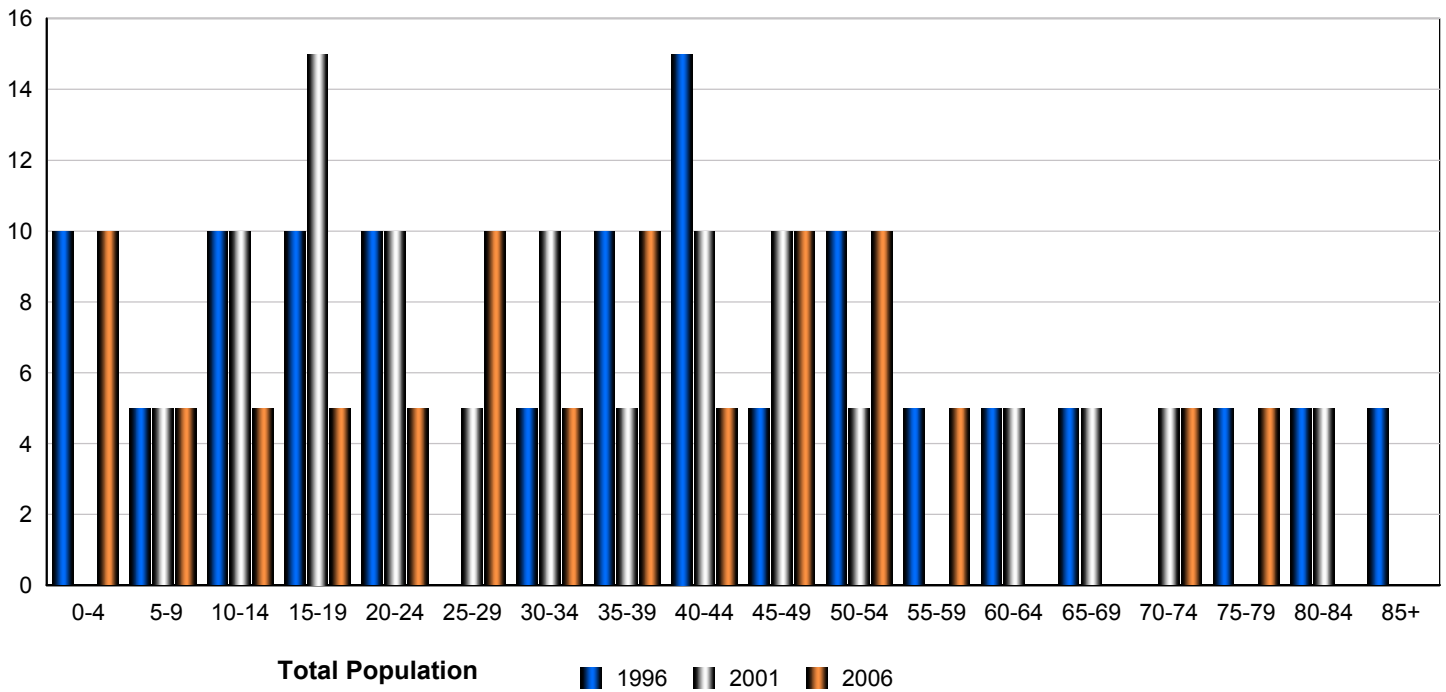

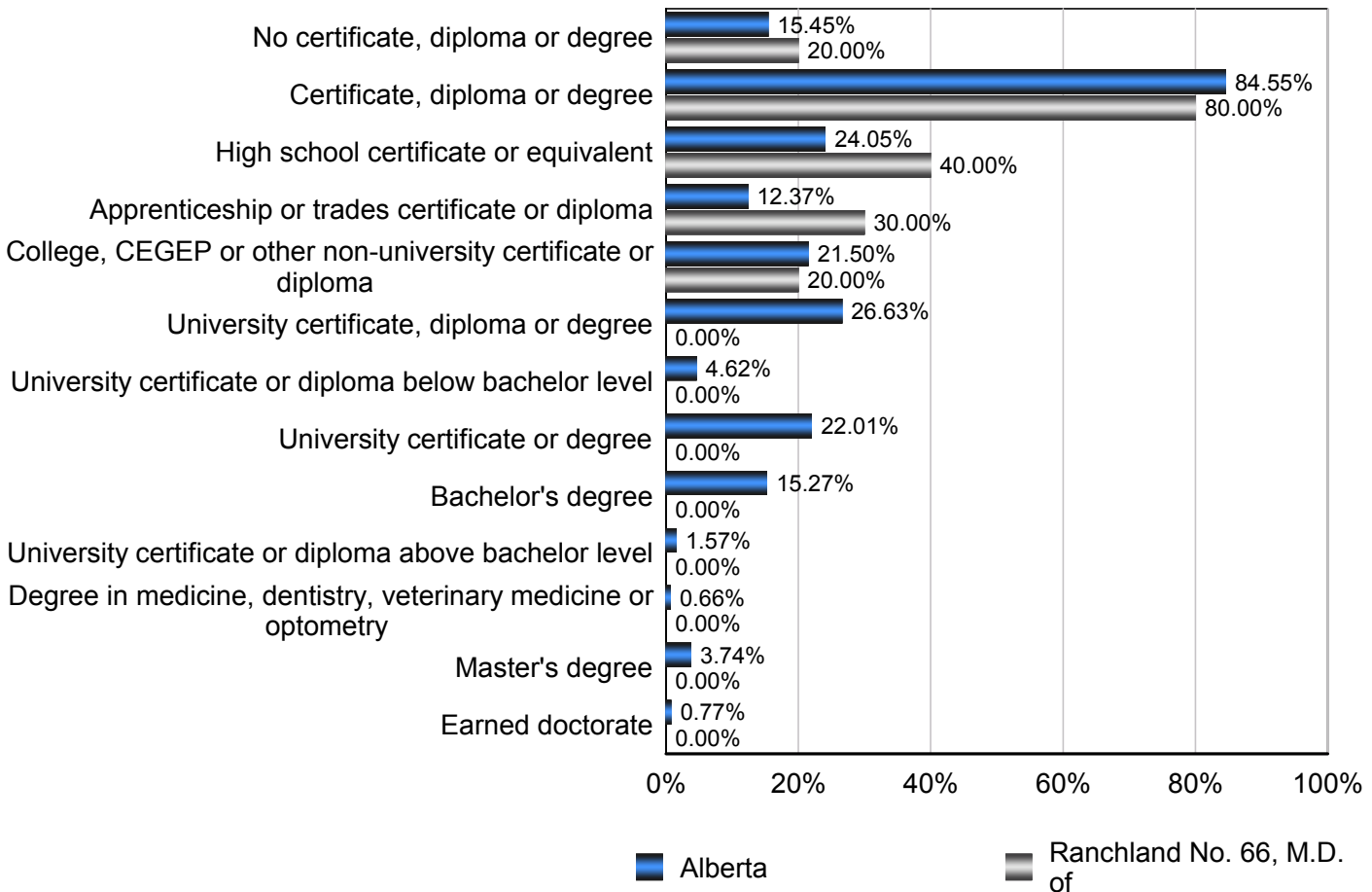

### Amount by Which the Highest Level of Schooling - Ranchland No. 66, M.D. of vs Provincial Average (2006)

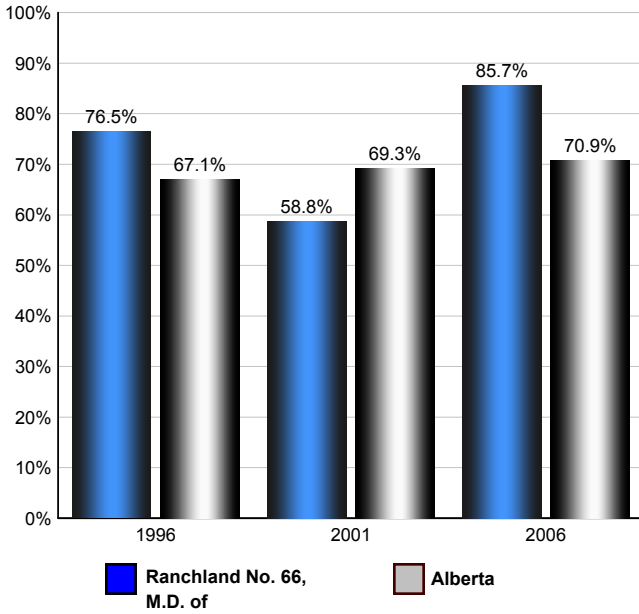

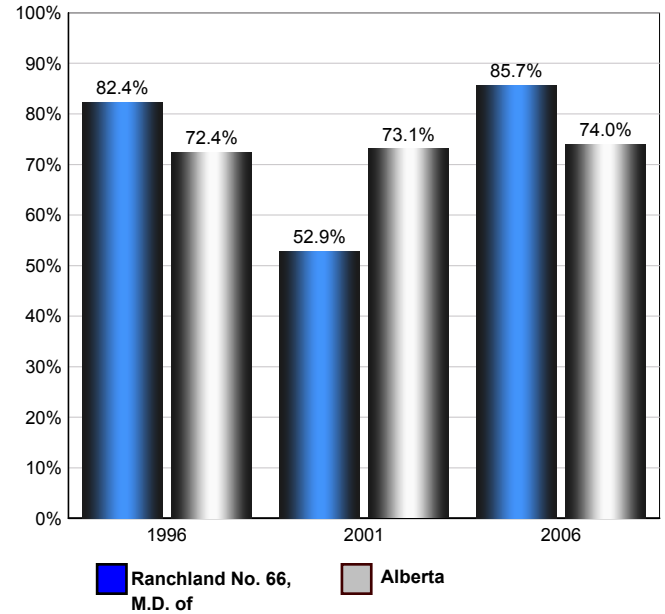
### Annual Labour Force Activity Rates - Ranchland No. 66, M.D. of vs Alberta

#### Employment Rate



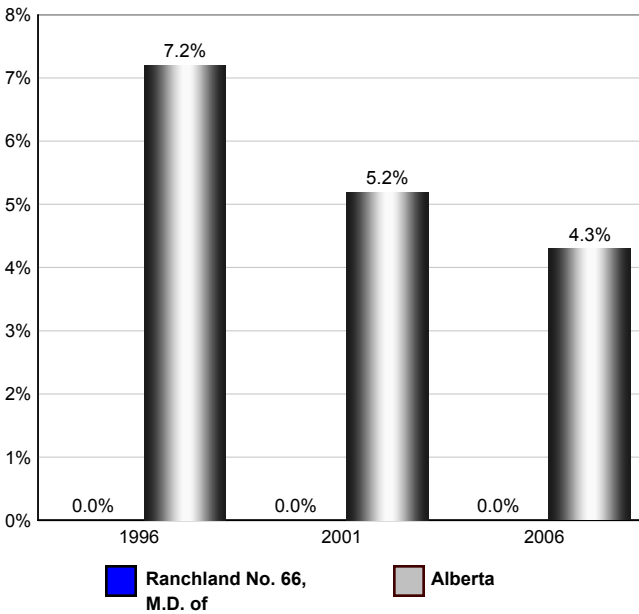

#### Participation Rate



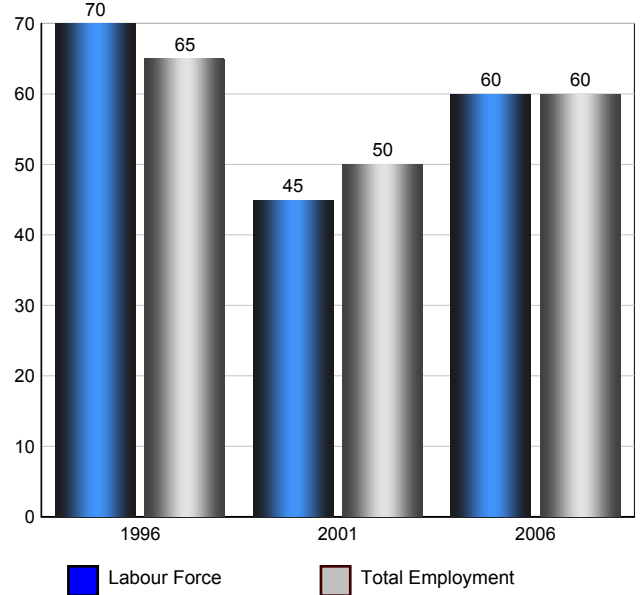

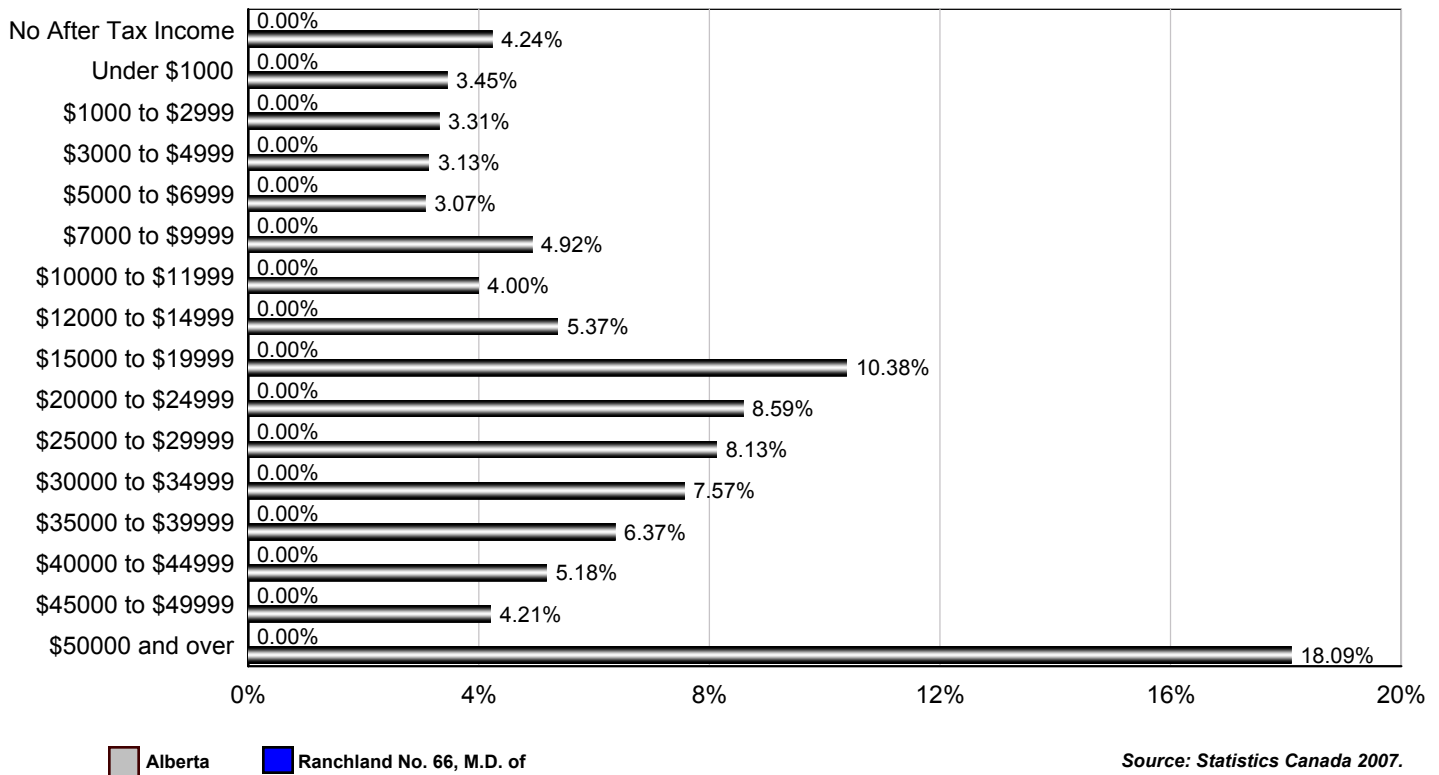

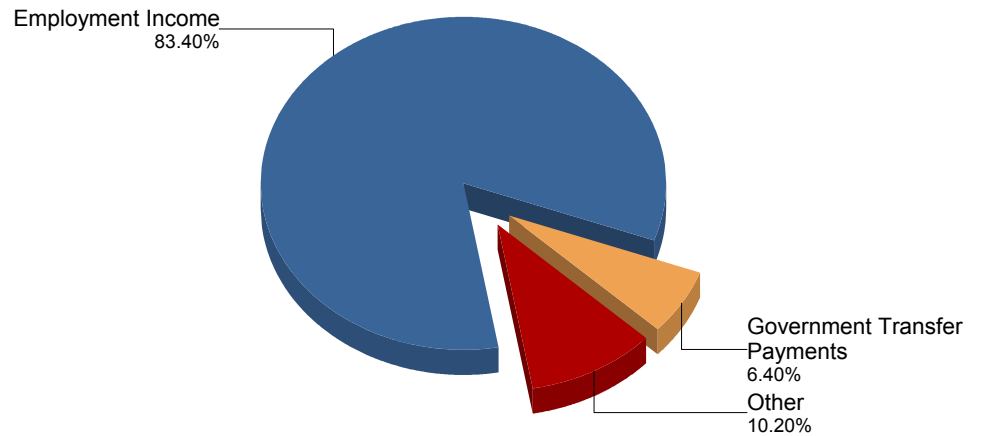

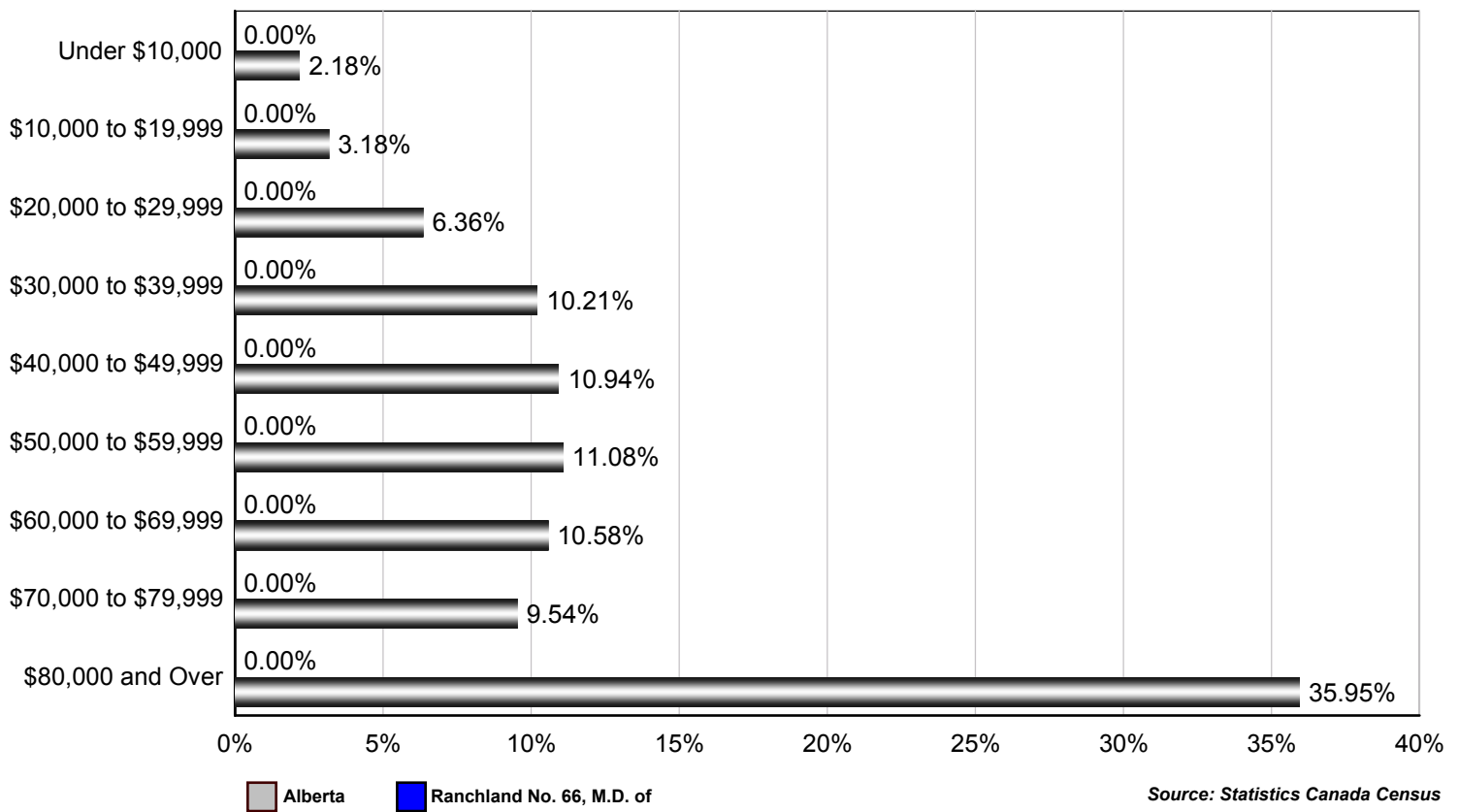

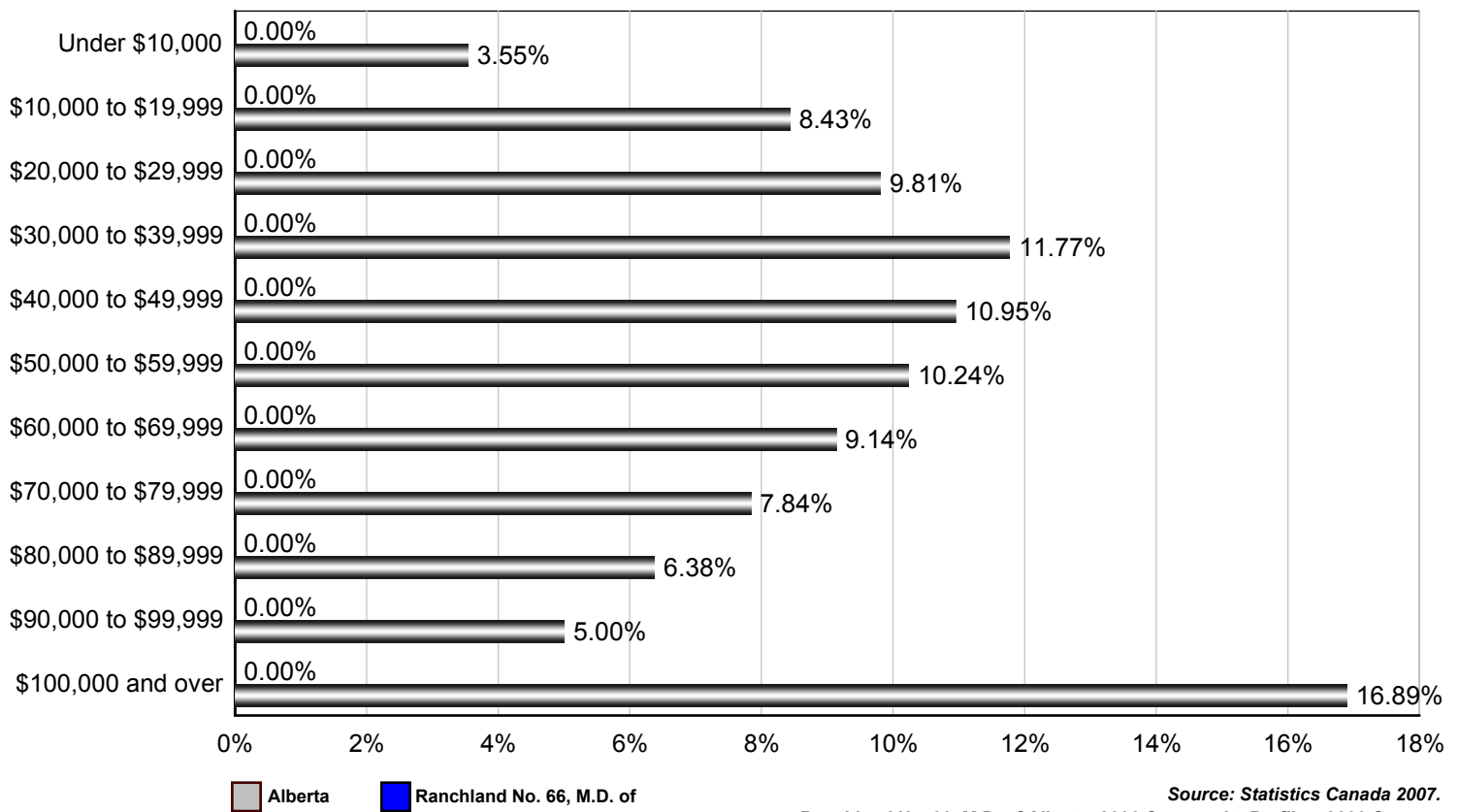

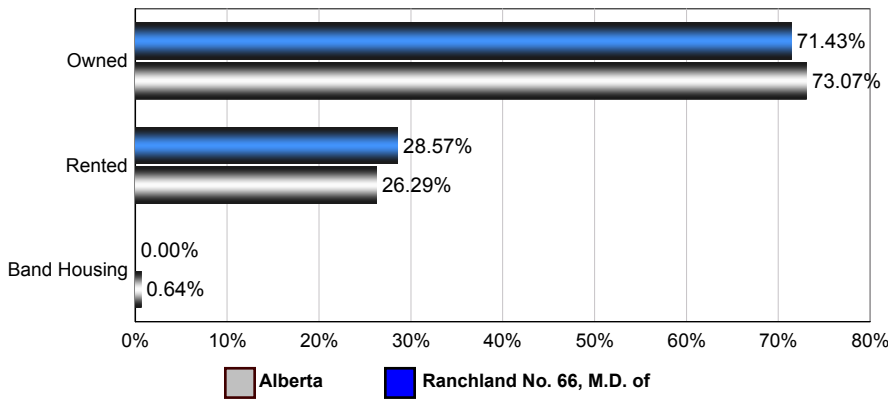

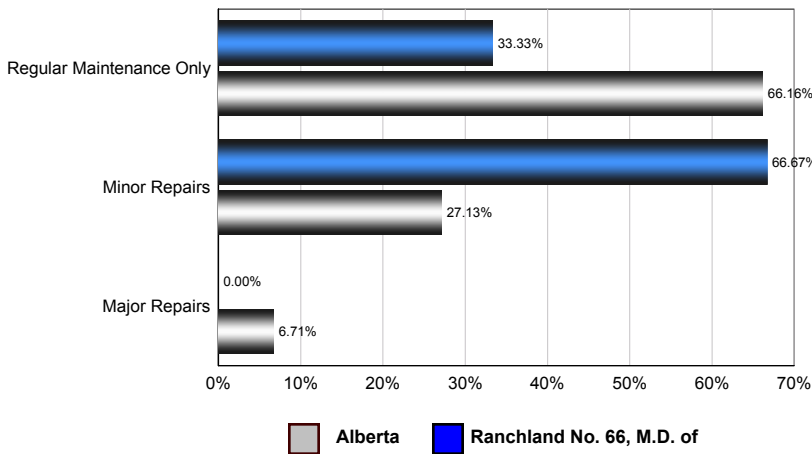

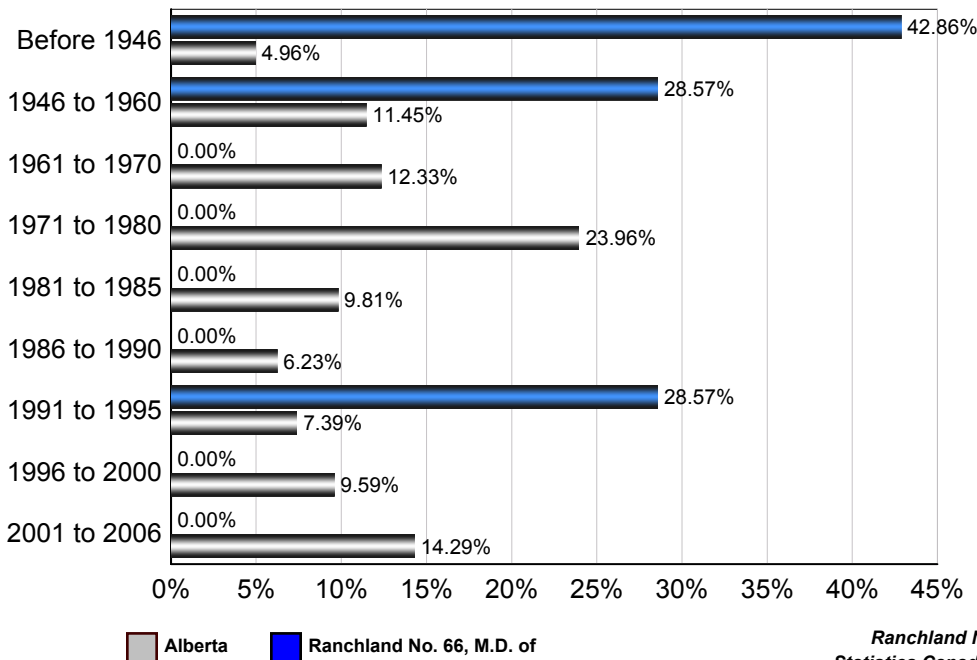

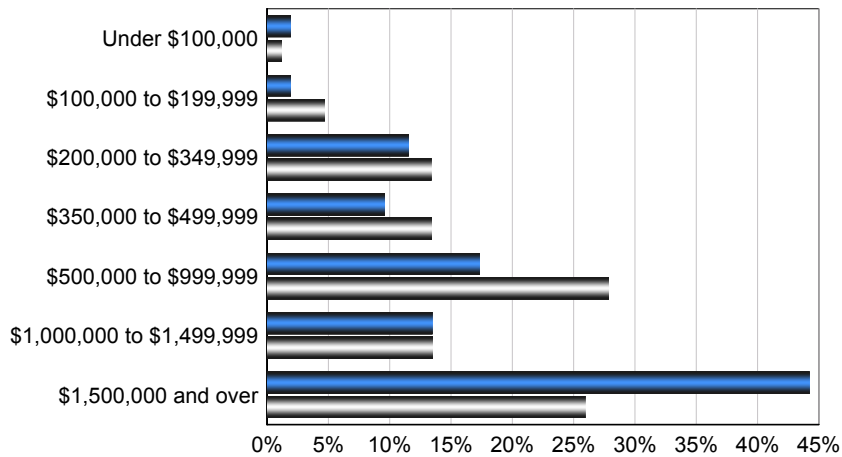

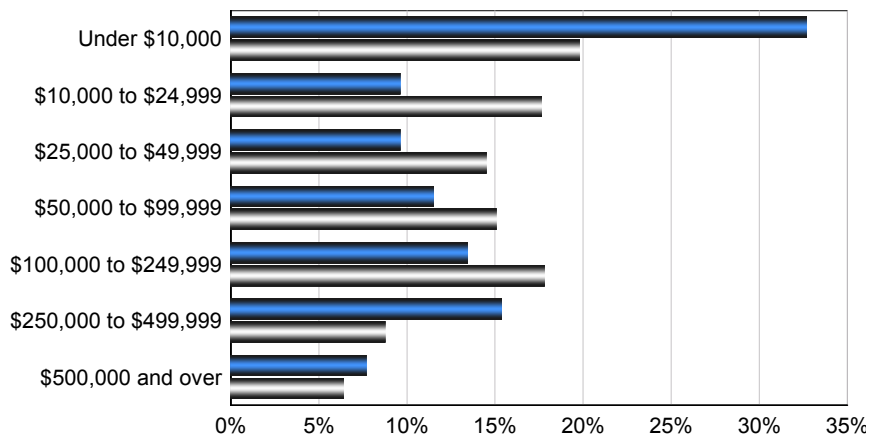

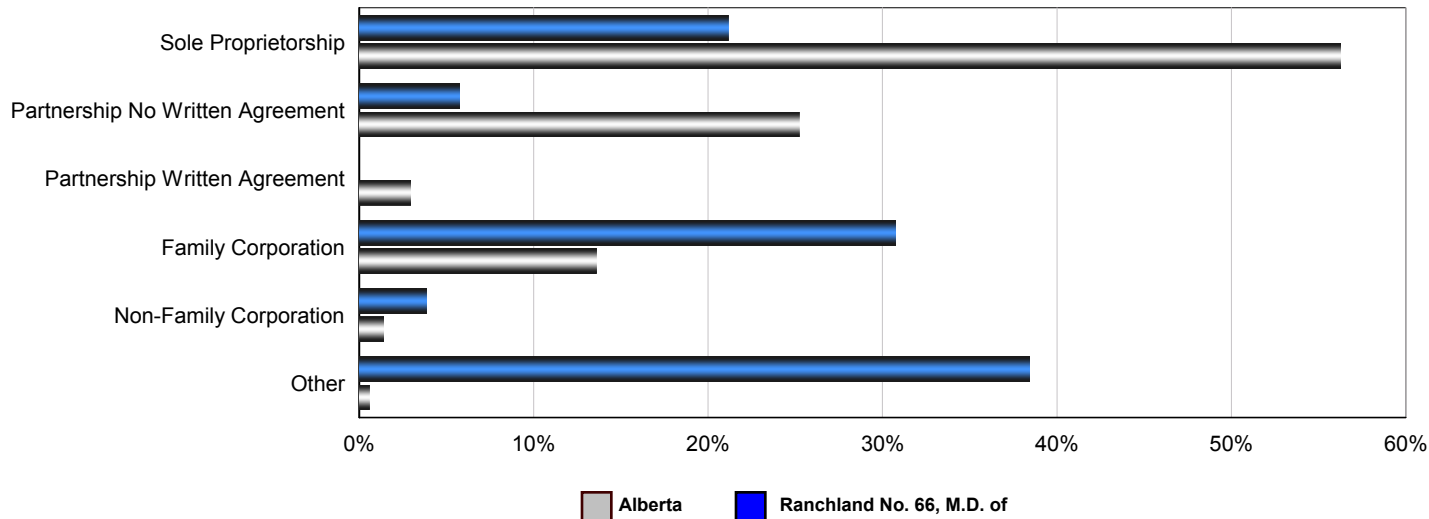

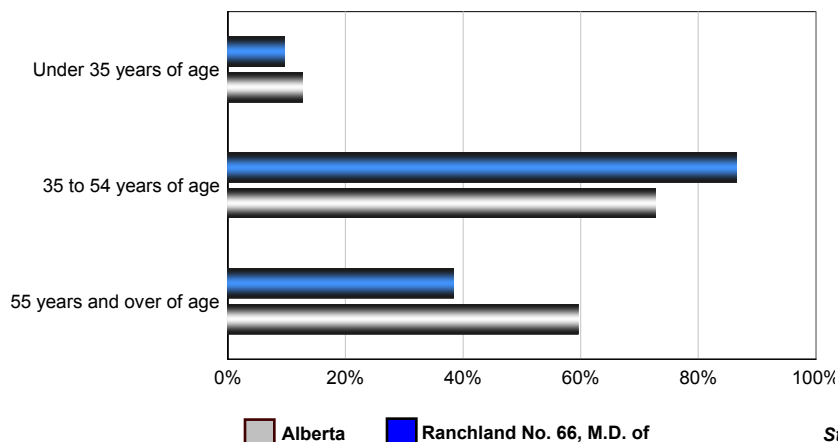
